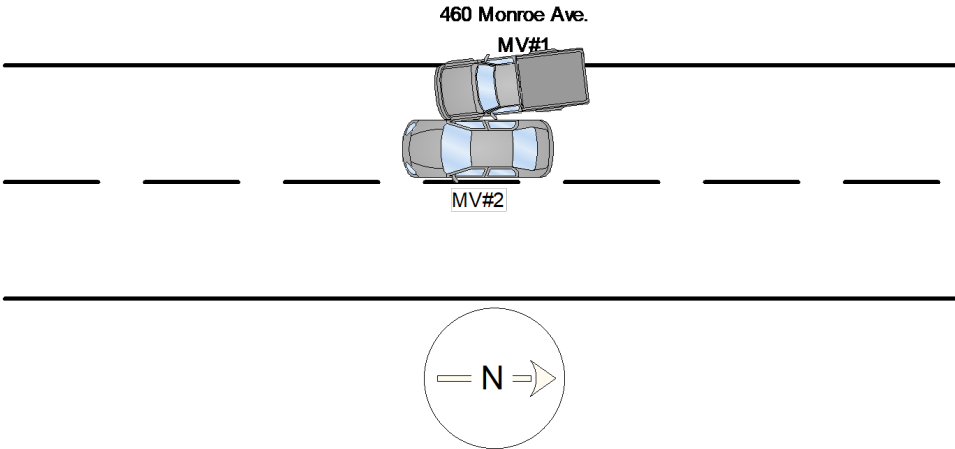

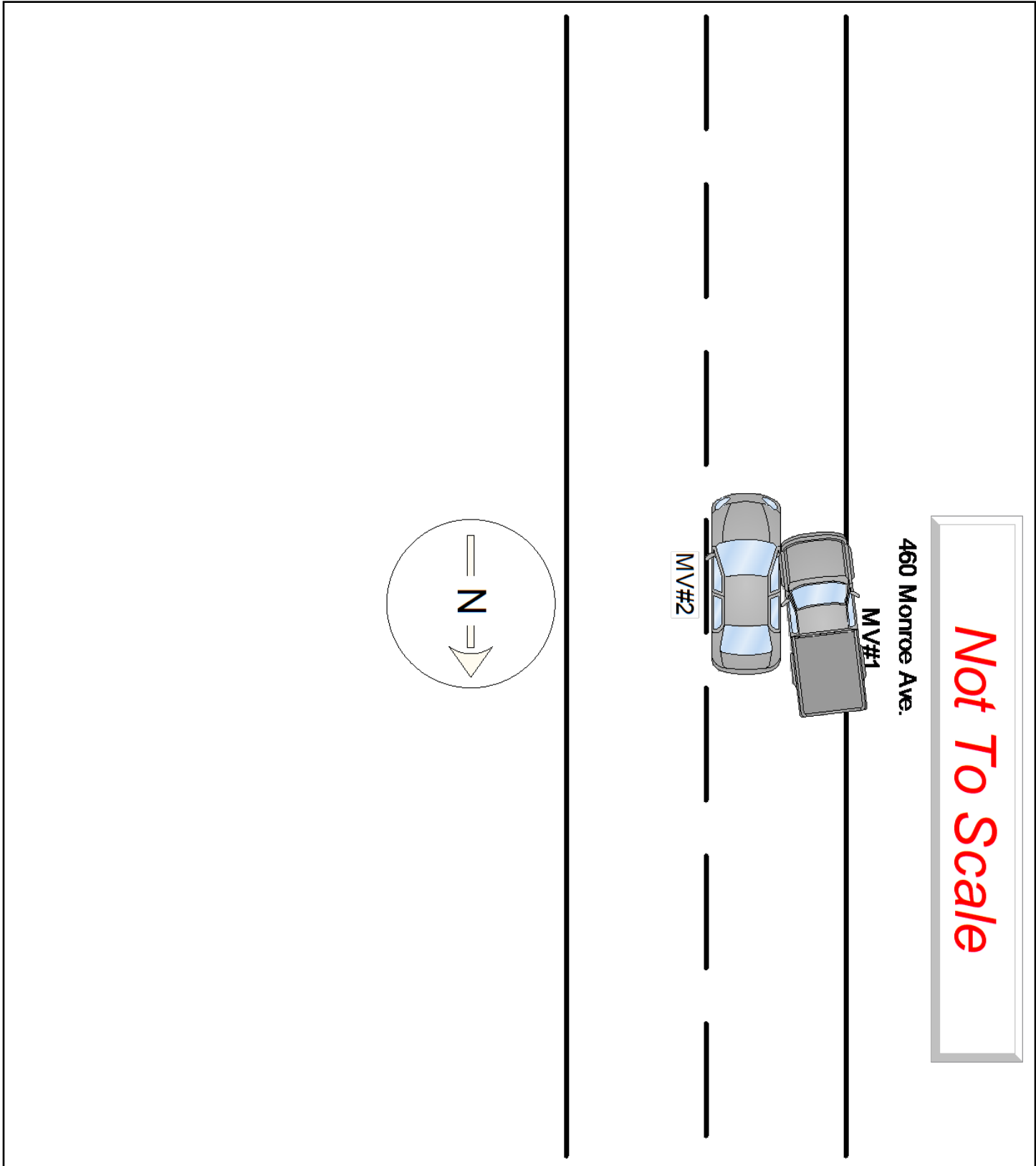
145. Crash Description/Narrative

On the above date and time, I Ofc. L. Boone responded to the area of 468 Monroe Ave. for a report of a Motor Vehicle accident. Upon my arrival, I was approached by the operator of MV#2. Same began to advise me that as he was traveling South Bound on Monroe Ave. MV#1 struck his vehicle as MV#1 was pulling out of one of the Driveways on the street. At this time, I then spoke to the operator of MV# 1 who began to advise me that as he was exiting his Driveway he and the operator of MV#2 collided. It shall be noted, MV#2 suffered damage to its passenger side mirror and side panel and MV#1 suffered minor damage to its driver side mirror. From this point, all parties were further advised accordingly. End of report. BWR
