145. Crash Description/Narrative

Vehicles 1 and 2 were located in the parking lot of 525 Jack Martin Boulevard at the Professional Arts Center. Vehicle 2 was legally parking in a parking spot. The occupant was sitting in the driver's seat, with the ignition off. Vehicle 1 was driving through the parking lot and was about to attempt pulling into a parking space to the left of Vehicle 2.

The occupant of Vehicle 2 stated that she observed the driver of Vehicle 1 come through the parking lot, and attempt a wide sweeping turn into the space next to her. She observed Vehicle 1 approaching, and knew that the driver of Vehicle 1 was going to strike her vehicle. She did not have time to honk the horn in an attempt to warn the driver of Vehicle 1 before contact.

The front right corner of the fender of Vehicle 1 came into contact with the rear left corner of Vehicle 2 causing scratching and light cosmetic damage to both vehicles. The occupant of Vehicle 2 felt the resulting contact of the two vehicles. I observed the damage to both vehicles, and the damage matched up in regards to the location and direction of damage.

145 Crash Description

The driver of Vehicle 1, an 87 year-old dialysis patient, had an appointment on the second floor of the building and was unable to wait for police to respond for the report. I located the driver in the second-floor office while being treated. She stated that the damage was from an earlier accident, and that if the occupant of Vehicle 2 saw her coming, she should have honked the horn.

No injuries were reported. Both vehicles were driven from the scene. No summonses were issued. Report needed by the owner of Vehicle 2 since it is a leased vehicle.

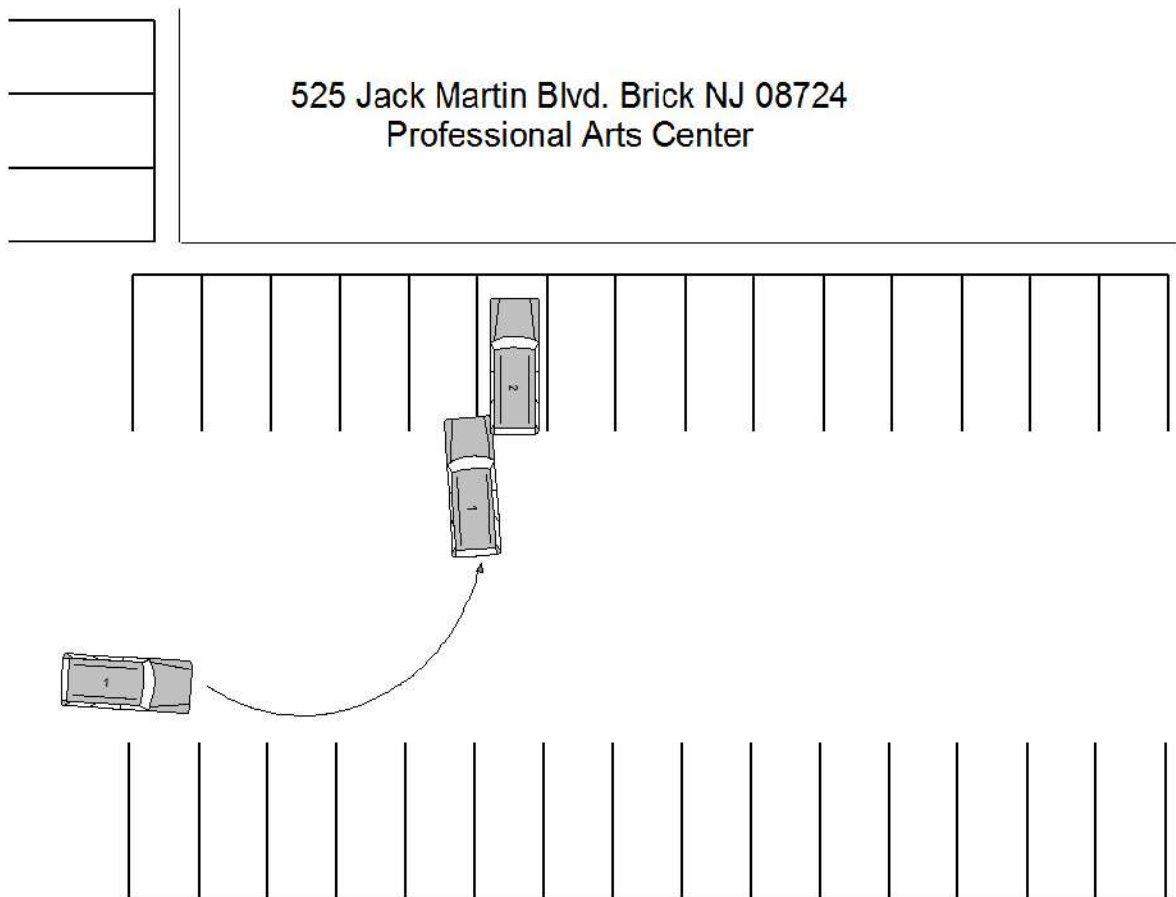
