135 Crash Description

On scene investigation concluded: Pedalcyclist #1 was traveling Eastbound in the Westbound shoulder of Rt. 88 in the area of the entrance to the Home Depot, 1722 Rt. 88. Vehicle #2 was stopped at a marked stop sign at the exit of the Home Depot parking lot, at the intersection of Rt. 88.

P #1 was traveling Eastbound in the shoulder, against the flow of traffic. P #1 was pedaling his electric Bicycle (Pedego 26" Classic City Commuter) approaching the entrance to the Home Depot. V #2 was stopped at the stop sign at the exit of the Home Depot observing the oncoming Westbound traffic. V #2 pulled forward into the shoulder of the roadway failing to observe P #1 at which time P #1 struck V #2. P #1 was unable to stop the bicycle and struck the passenger side of V #2, above the front tire. I observed minor dents on the passenger side hood and front quarter panel of V #2, and minor damage to the front fork and wheel of P #1.

The operator of P #1 stated, V #2 pulled forward into the shoulder and he was unable to stop. The operator of P #1 stated he believes the driver of V #2 is at fault for the MVA because he failed to observe him before entering the roadway.

The driver of V #2 stated he stopped at the stop sign and slowly pulled forward to view the Westbound traffic. The driver of V #2 stated he did not look to the right and failed to observe P #1 traveling Eastbound.

After striking V #2, the operator of P #1 was ejected from the bicycle and struck his head on the hood/windshield. The operator of P #1 had complained of head pain, neck pain, and had minor lacerations to his right arm. He was transported to Brick ER.

After concluding the on scene investigation, the operator of P #1 was at fault for traveling against the flow of traffic.

Both vehicles were moved from the scene prior to my arrival.

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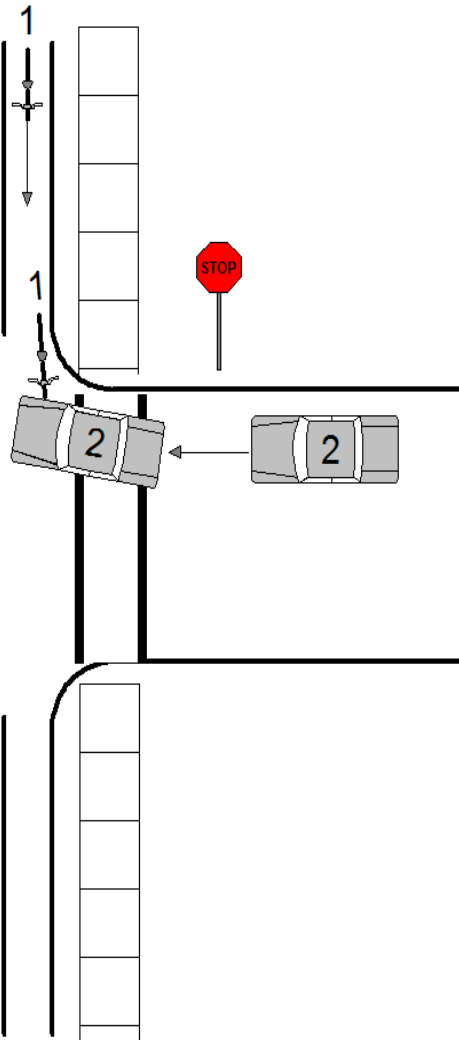
Motor Vehicle Crash Diagram
