135 Crash Description

Crash occurred in the parking lot of Home Depot, located at 1722 RT 88.

Driver #2 advised he just pulled out of a parking space and entered into the "Customer Loading Zone," to pick up his merchandise. He stated the loading zone was clear and he proceeded to pull up; however while doing so, vehicle #1 started to back up into the loading zone. Driver #2 advised he accelerated in an attempt to avoid having his vehicle struck; however he could not get out of the way quick enough and was still struck.

Driver #1 stated he had just finished loading up his truck in the "Customer Loading Zone." He advised he looked to make sure the roadway was clear and it was, so he proceeded to pull out and perform a "K" turn in an attempt to turn around and go out the other way. He advised he pulled out into the lane of travel and came to a stop. He then proceeded to back up; however unbeknownst to him he did not see vehicle #1, which had pulled into the Customer Loading Spot behind him. He subsequently backed into vehicle #2.

Both driver's advised they were not injured.

It should be noted Home Depot does have surveillance cameras outside; however there was nobody available who would have access to them. Driver #2 observed the Loading Zone empty and could only assume vehicle #1, which just pulled out, was going to continue on his way. Driver #2 would have no reason to believe vehicle #1 was going to back up. Furthermore, driver #2 had just as much right to be in the Loading Zone as vehicle #2 did prior to the crash. Because of this, my determination is vehicle #1 is at fault for backing unsafely.

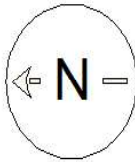
