135 Crash Description

Vehicle #1 was exiting the parking lot of Camp Mall (1905 Rt. 88) attempting to make a left turn onto Rt. 88 Westbound. Vehicle #2 was traveling on Rt. 88 Westbound, in the area of Camp Mall.

The driver of Vehicle #1 failed to observe Vehicle #2, and proceeded into the lane of travel that Vehicle #2 was traveling in. Vehicle #1 struck the driver side (front) door of Vehicle #2 then entered the Eastbound lane of traffic before striking a concrete parking space marker in the Camp Mall parking lot.

The driver of Vehicle #1 stated that she did not observe Vehicle #2 when she had pulled onto Rt. 88 Westbound. The driver of Vehicle #2 stated that she was traveling West bound and that Vehicle #1 made a left turn out of Camp Mall, directly into the side of her vehicle.

There were no injuries reported and both vehicle were damaged. Vehicle #1 was stuck on a curb and had to be towed into the parking lot. Vehicle #2 had damage to the driver's side doors and was towed from the scene by a private tow company.

The driver of Vehicle #1 was issued a summons for Careless Driving (E14-005983).

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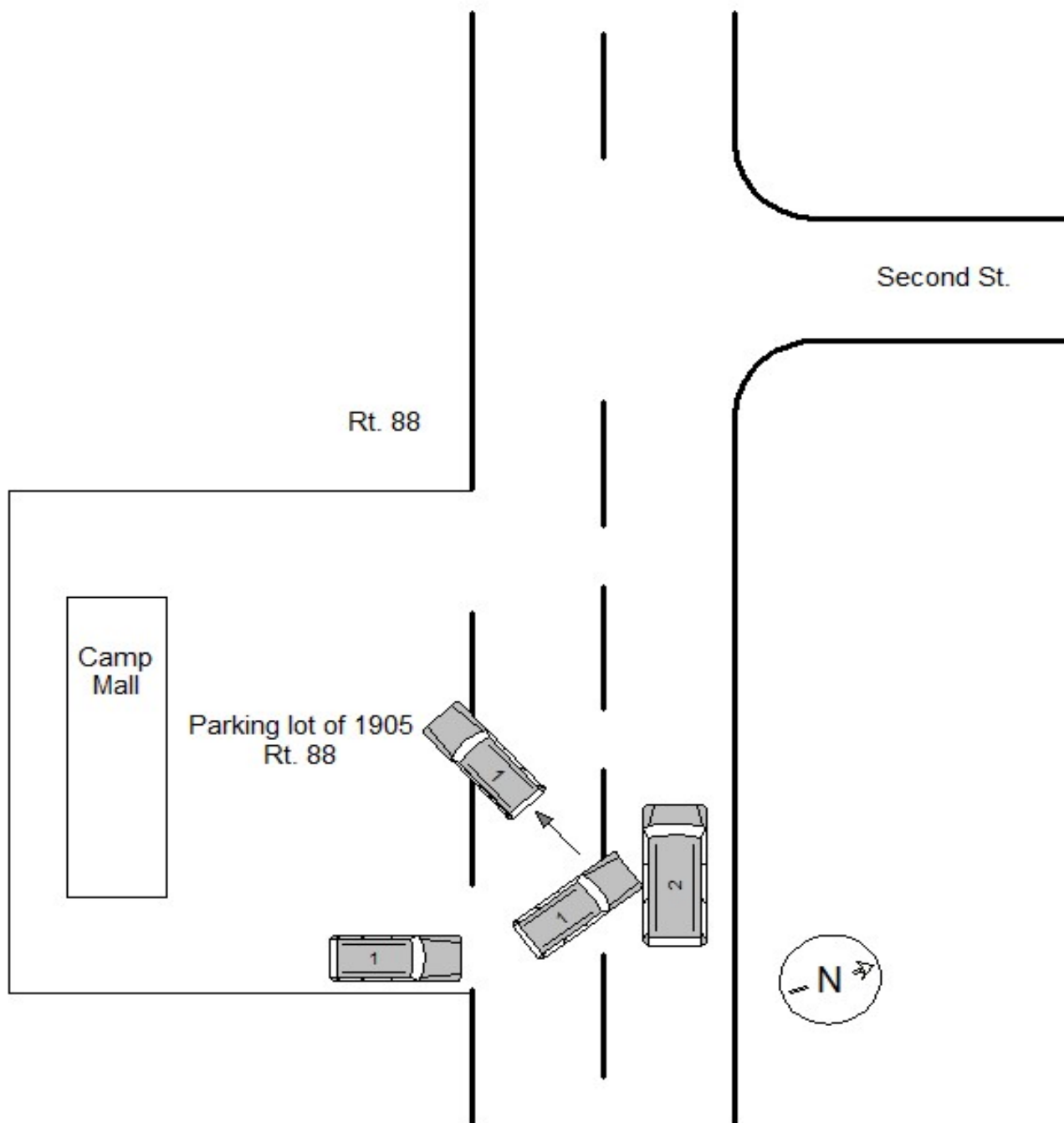
Motor Vehicle Crash Diagram
