135 Crash Description

While traveling west bound on Rt. 88 in the area of 1450 Rt.88, vehicle 1 was attempting to pass vehicle 2 in a no passing zone, when it struck the rear left bumper of vehicle 2. After the impact, vehicle 1 continued west bound on Rt. 88 at a high rate of speed. While a passenger was on the phone with 911, Driver 2 followed vehicle 1 for several miles before it stopped in the driveway of 1229 Todd Ct. Lakewood NJ. Driver 2 further stated that after vehicle 1 stopped, the short, stocky Hispanic male ran away from the vehicle. Upon the arrival of the Lakewood Police Dept, a check of the area was conducted with negative results for the driver of vehicle 1. While checking the vehicle, several empty beer bottles were found through out the vehicle's interior and an empty wallet. No paper work (registration, insurance card) for the vehicle was located. A Business name and phone number, Lyon Construction 1-888-850-1047, were located on the truck and attempts to make contact were negative at this time. Vehicle 1 was towed from the scene and impounded at Surfside Towing for further investigation. Vehicle 2 sustained only minor damage and vehicle 1 sustained moderate damage consistent with colliding with vehicle 2. No injuries were reported at this time. During a follow up investigation, the owner of the vehicle, Junior Santos, was contacted via phone and responded to the Brick Police Dept. Santos provided the vehicles valid insurance information and advised that the vehicle 1 is one of 20 vehicles he has for his business. He further advised that vehicle 1 has been stored at an employee's, Eduardo Reyes, residence in Lakewood for the last 3 months due to slow business and it shouldn't have been on road at the time of the crash. Reyes advised Santos that he was not driving vehicle 1 during the crash but someone else was. Santos advised that he would continue to attempt to find out who the driver was and contact the Lakewood Police Dept. to file a report for his vehicle being taken with out consent.

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Motor Vehicle Crash Diagram

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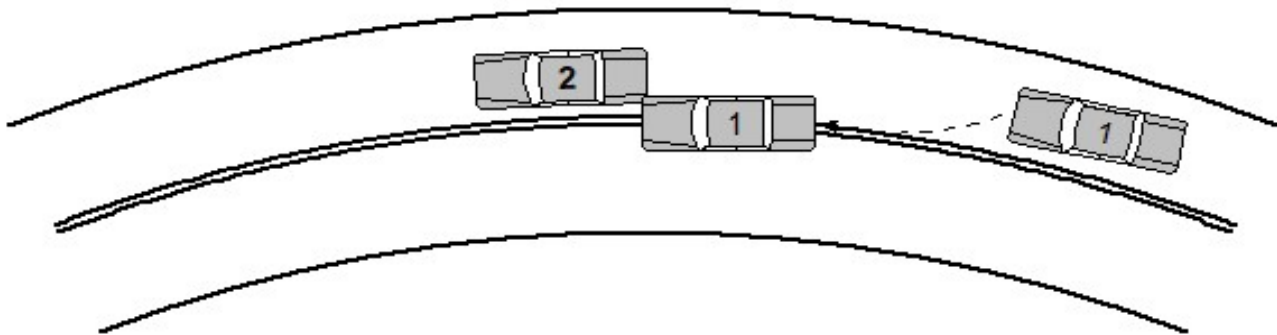
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134 Crash Diagram (NOT TO SCALE)
