135 Crash Description

On Monday May 21, 2012 at approximately 0114 hours, I was dispatched to 1459 Highway 88 Apartment 8A in reference to a robbery. During the course of the investigation, the victim, Robert Hagaman, told me he was struck by the suspect's vehicle as it fled the scene of the robbery. Hagaman described the vehicle as a gold colored Chevrolet Blazer bearing partial NJ registration ZHL. He stated it left the parking lot and headed west on Highway 88. Hagaman later identified Robert Barrows as the suspect and operator of the vehicle that struck him.

Hagaman stated that the vehicle ran over his left foot and that his elbow went through the windshield. He refused medical attention.

A search of the NJ motor vehicle records located a 2001 GMC Jimmy bearing NJ registration ZHL31F registered to Robert Barrows' mother, Patricia Barrows. A check of the surrounding areas and Barrows' known addresses produced negative results for the suspect vehicle.
