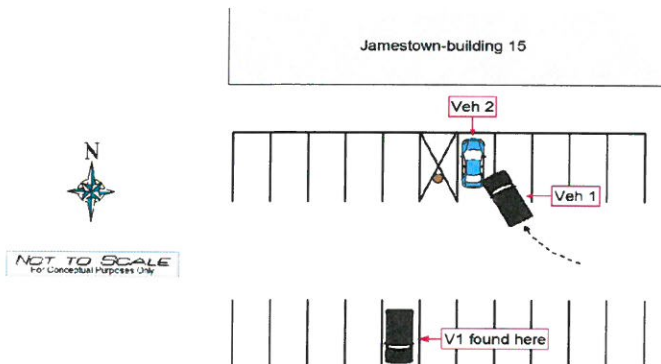

145 Crash Description/Narrative

The owner of vehicle #2 reported that he parked his vehicle in the parking lot of Jamestown Apartments near building 15 on 12/1/2017 at approximately 1945 hours. When he returned to his vehicle at approximately 0900 hours on 12/2/2017 he found that vehicle #1 had collided with the passenger side rear fender of his car while it had been parked. The driver of vehicle #1 did not attempt to notify the owner of vehicle #2 or the police. I was able to observe the fresh damage to vehicle #2 which consisted of a low-speed impact dent to the fender and a group of several black horizontal paint transfer lines consistent with a sideswipe. A short time later I located vehicle #1 parked and unoccupied across the parking lot aisle approximately 30 feet away. An examination of vehicle #1 revealed fresh damage to the driver's side front corner and fender that exactly matched the damage suffered to vehicle #2. This damage included low-speed impact damage to the front bumper on the driver's side and fresh scratches to the front fender and wheel trim. This damage was very fresh as flakes of black paint were still hanging off. It was apparent that the front part of vehicle #1 had been recently repainted prior to this collision and the damage I found occurred after this paint job. When I looked up the license plate of vehicle #1 in the TRPD Spillman database I found that it had been involved in a hit-and-run collision in Toms River on 9/22/2017. In this case the vehicle had been found by TRPD officers in the Jamestown Village parking lot with the driver Saul Jimenez-Sanchez passed out in the driver's seat with the vehicle running and was found to be DWI. I made numerous attempts to contact Mr. Jimenez as his residence today with negative results.
