145. Crash Description/Narrative

Upon arrival, both vehicles were located in the rear of 415 Jack Martin Blvd (Meridian Nursing and Rehab) where shipping/receiving is located as well as a thoroughfare is located to access the Veterans Clinic.

Driver #1 said he works at the Veterans Clinic and was utilizing the thoroughfare to get there when he saw Vehicle #2 already starting to back up. Driver #1 said he was directly behind vehicle #2 and even started to reverse out of the vehicle #2's way when he said the "asshole" driver swung the truck to wide and collided into my vehicle. The damage to vehicle #1 was primarily on the left rear panel and the impact caused the rear bumper to dislodge from vehicle #1. Driver #1 said if you look at vehicle #2, there will be damage to the front right bumper. Since Driver #1's series of events were not consistent with the damage to both vehicles, I asked Driver #1 to explain to me again how the collision occurred. Driver #1 repeated the same sequence of events he mentioned the first time.

Driver #2 said he had to back into the shipping/receiving area of 415 Jack Martin Blvd so he proceeded to pull his vehicle past the area and positioned vehicle #2 in the middle of the Thoroughfare. Driver #2 said he started backing up with the vehicles rear back up audible on . He observed vehicle #1 while he was backing up but

believed vehicle #1 stopped to allow him to finishing backing up. Driver #2 said the next thing he knew, vehicle #1 was next to his right front bumper. Driver #2 said by the time he realized it, the front right bumper of vehicle #2 collided into the left rear bumper of vehicle #1.

On scene investigation determined driver#1's story of how the collision occurred was not consistent with the damage sustained by both vehicles. The damages appeared to be more consistent with Driver #2's sequence of events and that Driver #1 could have possibly been attempting to pass vehicle #2 while it was backing up.

Since there wasn't any witnesses and both drivers had conflicting stories, it was determined both drivers could have displayed better judgement while operating their vehicles which ultimately could have possibly avoided the crash from happening.

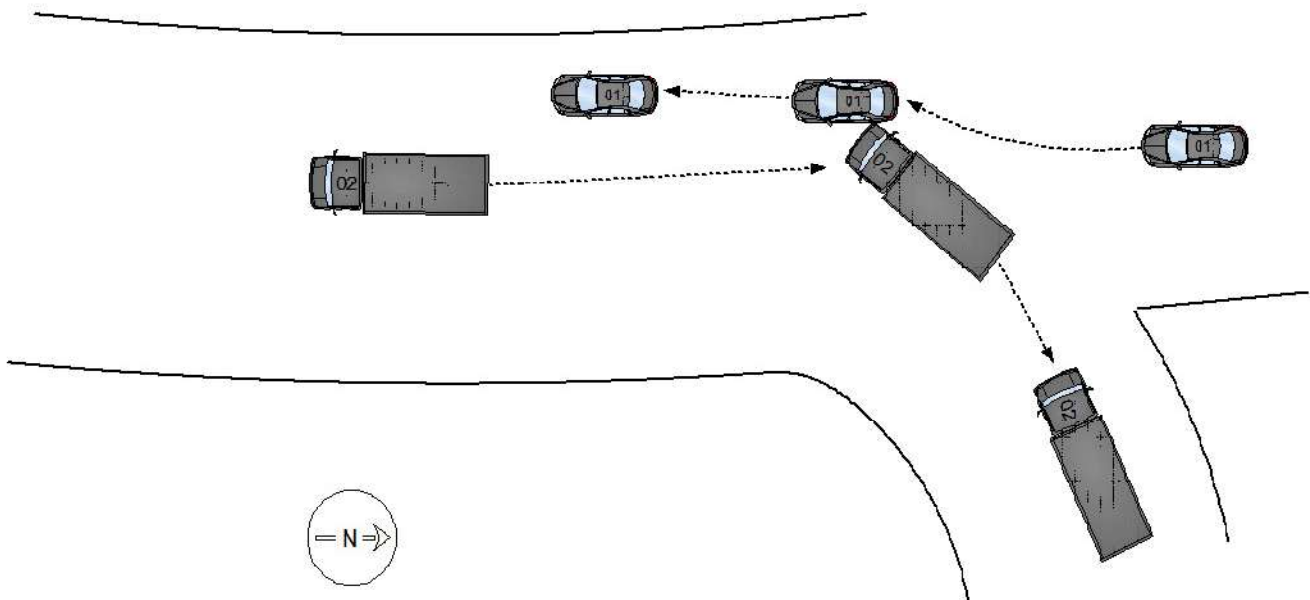
