145. Crash Description/Narrative

Vehicle #01 was traveling east on State Highway 88 between Sullivan Road and Burnt Bridge Avenue. As vehicle #01 was passing by the Colonial Funeral Home, it left the road to the right and struck a large utility pole. #JC283BK, with the right front bumper / fender area of vehicle #01, causing significant damage to vehicle #01 and a crack in the utility pole.

The impact caused vehicle #01 to rotate around the utility pole to the left and come to rest blocking the eastbound lane and partially blocking the westbound lane.

There were no tire marks or roadway evidence observed that would indicate any braking or counter steering occurred by Driver #01 to avoid the crash. There front windshield was damaged from the inside in such a way that it appeared driver #01 struck the windshield with his face or head.

Driver #01 was unconscious and unresponsive. By-standers were attempting to gain access to the vehicle when they observed another vehicle traveling west on State Highway 88, at what they believed to be a high rate of speed. Several attempts to signal the driver of the oncoming car was made, unsuccessfully. This other vehicle

struck vehicle #01 in the left rear corner panel / bumper area thereby causing more damage to vehicle #01.

Reference the motor vehicle crash report submitted by Ptl M. Beyers under case # 2018-00063745. None of the bystanders were injured during this crash and we were unable to determine if this second crash caused or worsened any of the injuries previously sustained by Driver #01.

Driver #01 was removed from the vehicle and transported to the Meridian-Jersey Shore University Regional Trauma Center. During his treatment and transport the odor of an alcoholic beverage was detected coming from Driver #01. At the Trauma Center, a large quantity of CDS was discovered on Driver #01's person. The CDS was collected by Ptl. Dinnebeil who responded to the hospital with Driver #01.

Driver #01 was suffering from a pelvis / hip injury and a head injury as a result of striking the windshield of Vehicle #01.

Based upon the circumstances of the crash, the drivers decreased level of consciousness, the odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath, the CDS found on his person and the need for hospital staff to administer narcotics and medications necessary to treat him, a sample of Driver #01's blood was collected based upon exigency and will be sent to the laboratory for testing. For information regarding the D.U.I. / CDS arrest, reference the case form report submitted by Ptl. Dinnebeil under case # 63744-18.

Vehicle #01 was impounded to Sandy's Service Center as directed by John's law.

JCP&L was contacted and responded to examine the damaged utility pole.

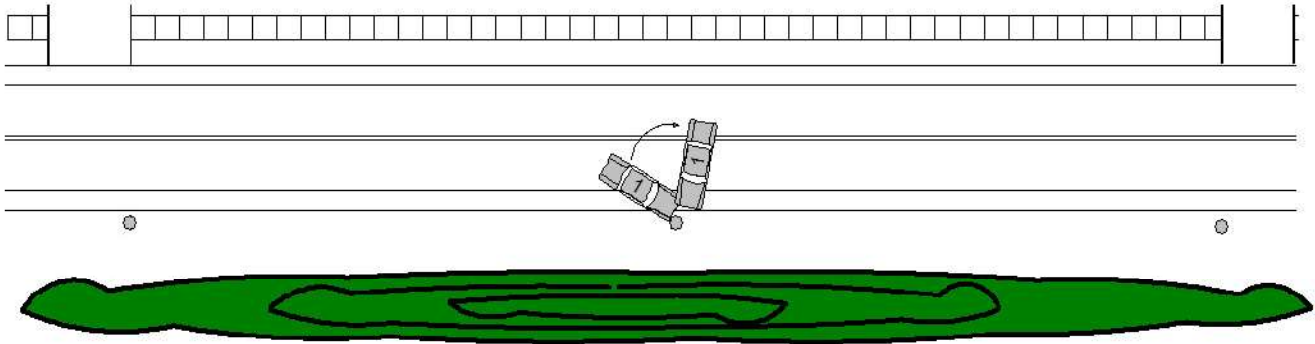
