Regarding the November 13 combined meeting, will there be a discussion item on justification for removing a speaker for wearing a mask?

The case cited by Mr. Burns, *Grant v. Slattery*, doesn't support giving the presiding officer discretion to have a speaker removed for wearing a mask.

In *Grant*, Moshe Grant violated a **written** school board policy banning offensive language on school premises and **requiring** a mask (this was during COVID).

Grant sued Slattery for sending him a warning letter threatening removal and prosecution if Grant violated the policies again. Grant was neither removed from a meeting, nor prosecuted.

Dear Members of the Edison Town Council,

I am writing to formally demand that the Edison Town Council immediately cease and desist from enforcing the policy that requires members of the public to remove their masks while speaking at public meetings. This policy is not only a violation of public health guidelines but also infringes upon the constitutional rights of individuals attending these meetings.

The policy in question is in direct conflict with established case law and constitutional protections. Specifically, the Third Circuit Court of Appeals has ruled that the refusal to wear a mask during a public health emergency does not constitute protected speech under the First Amendment (*Falcone v. Freehold Township Board of Education*, 2024)¹. This ruling underscores that while individuals may voice their opposition to mask mandates through various means, disobeying a masking requirement is not protected by the Constitution.

Furthermore, the Kentucky Court of Appeals in *Campbell County Board of Education v. Ken Moellman, Sr.* (2023) found that imposing mask requirements as a condition for attending public meetings violates open meetings laws, which state that no condition other than those required for the maintenance of order shall apply to the attendance of any member of the public at any meeting of a public agency². This precedent clearly indicates that the Edison Town Council's policy is unlawful.

In light of these legal precedents, I urge the Edison Town Council to immediately revoke the policy requiring the removal of masks while speaking at public meetings. Failure to do so will result in further legal action to protect the constitutional rights of the public and ensure compliance with established laws.

I look forward to your prompt response and the immediate cessation of this unlawful policy.
