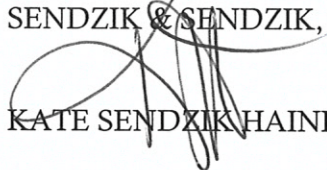
The South Brunswick Board of Fire Commissioners for the South Brunswick Fire District No. 3 received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request sent on November 2, 2023. This response is being provided to you on November 13, 2023. Your OPRA request sought access to the following: "Kindly provide the number of Certified Interior Structural Firefighters trained and state certified for Interior Operations. If you have drivers who are not capable please don't include them. Please specify whether career or volunteer."

Please be advised that under the Open Public Records Act access is limited to requests for government records that are not exempt under the law. Records are defined as "any paper, written or printed book, document, drawing, map, plan, photograph, microfilm, data processed or image processed document, information stored or maintained electronically or by sound-recording or in a similar device ..that has been made, maintained or kept on file, or that has been received in the cause of its official business. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1. It is not a resource for asking questions to obtain information. As your request does not specify a public record as defined by the statute, no response is required.

If you believe that your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your county.
