All 911 and non-emergency calls including Police CAD log for town of Neptune City for the time period February 12, 2024 - February 22, 2024. Identify nature of emergency and what departments were dispatched.

Monmouth County Sheriff's Office would maintain records of 911 calls relayed to the Borough of Neptune City.

The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
