MY BWC, PO POLLARA'S BWC, and SGT. TAYLOR'S BWC ALL RECORDED THE FOLLOWING CALL FOR SERVICE:

On 5/2/22, PO. Pollara and I responded to 308 Union Ave for a police stand-by, to escort Megan Benjamin, along with her friend Tiffany Acevedo, as she retrieved some of her belongings out of the home. The following should be noted: Megan advised she has an active TRO against her husband, Eric York. She showed me an electronic copy of the order, reference Case #22NT09029. The order advised Megan is allowed to come to the home with a police escort to retrieve belongings until 5/20/22. The order did not state that she could not have anyone come with her into the home to assist her in retrieving her belongings, nor did it specify if York needed to be contacted upon coming to the home. Megan further advised she and York both own the home, but she voluntarily left the home with their kids for safety precautions.

Upon arrival at the home we made contact with resident, Devin Jones (York's cousin) who advised York was not home. Benjamin stated she did not wish for Jones to be in the house while she retrieved her belongings as she felt uncomfortable with him around and that her safety was at risk. PO. Pollara and I spoke with Jones about Benjamin's concerns and he agreed to stay outside to avoid any potential conflicts. Benjamin and Acevedo proceeded with gathering Benjamin's belongings as we stood by.

While standing by Eric York, who was at work, called Jones on the phone as he wished to speak with police about Benjamin having another person in the house while retrieving property. York believed Benjamin was not allowed to do this based upon the order. I attempted to advise York that the order did not mention any such thing and further explain the order, but he did not wish to listen to me.

Moments later, as I was attempting to explain the situation / order to Jones for him to relay the information to Eric, Tassie York (Eric's mother) arrived on scene. Tassie appeared to be extremely disgruntled with the situation and interrupted my explanation to Jones. I again attempted to explain the situation / order to the both of them, but Tassie interrupted and did not wish to listen. It appeared she was also irate about Benjamin having another person at the house to gather her belongings. Tassie further advised she was calling Deputy Chief Fisher and requested a supervisor to be on scene. She began speaking on the phone with the Deputy Chief and then handed the phone to me. I spoke with Deputy Chief Fisher and informed him of the situation. He informed me to have a supervisor respond to our location to further assist. Sgt. Taylor arrived and spoke with Tassie in detail about the situation and the order.

Benjamin finished gathering her belongings and left the area with Acevedo without further incident. The call for service was concluded and nothing further was needed.
