Thank you for reaching out to discuss with the Township's application for a grant addressing the sidewalks. Upon our discussion, and subsequent discussion with Rochelle Park Board of Education's President, Mr. Trawinski, and Vice-President, Mr. Kral, you, and me, the Rochelle Park Board of Education (Board) supports the Township of Rochelle Park's (Township) Transportation Alternative Set-Aside Grant Application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for William Street & Lincoln Avenue Pedestrian Safety Improvements.

It is understood that the Township is seeking grant funding for pedestrian safety improvements for William Street and Lincoln Avenue from 325 ft. east of Central Avenue (County Route 44) to Oldis Street. The proposed improvements will promote pedestrian safety and provide improved accessibility for all residents, especially school children attending Midland Elementary School. RE: Status Report for Work Session Meeting – December 9, 2020

The following is a brief summary of the status of various projects and matters with which we are involved for the Township of Rochelle Park:

ROP-101 Rochelle Avenue and Railroad Avenue Intersection Improvement Project

- Design proposal submitted by our office on January 21, 2019 to utilize preliminary plans prepared to complete design. Received authorization for design at the April 10, 2019 meeting. We are waiting for signage and striping plan from the County. Expect design to be completed within 2 weeks of receiving plan from the County.
- The easement taking maps have been updated and completed by the former Township Engineer and have been reviewed and approved by the County. The Township has held final easement meeting with property owners.
- Received e-mail from the County on October 8, 2020 indicating that the traffic signal plan was reviewed by their consultant that specializes in traffic signals in the vicinity of railroad crossings. Some changes to the signal plan are required. We are waiting for the plans and comments from the County.

ROP-102 Sprout Brook Stream Cleaning/Outfall Stabilization Project

- Received necessary NJDEP permits on May 8, 2020.
- Meeting held with administration on July 22, 2020 to review project budget and schedule. Authorized to proceed with preparation of bid documents.
- Project expected to be bid in Winter 2020 with the work proceeding in the first quarter of 2021.

ROP-104 Saddle River Basin – Flood Mitigation Project

- Meeting held on August 20, 2020 with the County and affected municipalities.
- Meeting held on August 25, 2020 with Rochelle Park representatives to develop the municipality's plan and schedule based on meeting with County.
- Received drone footage from Police Department on September 4, 2020. We reviewed footage and performed field evaluation. Met with Township on September 29, 2020 to review.
- We have provided the Township with a detailed report with exhibit detailing our findings on October 7, 2020.
- Meeting held on October 20, 2020 with Municipal and County Officials. It should be noted that Rochelle Park has been very proactive in this matter.
- The County must follow up with the other affected municipalities.

ROP-110 Matthew Field ADA/Bleacher Improvement Project

- The Township has received a \$51,000 matching Grant from the Bergen County Open Space Trust Fund.
- Proposal for Engineering Design and Inspection Services provided to the Township on February 10, 2020. Authorized to proceed with bid documents.
- Expect to provide Township with draft plans and specifications for review by December 11, 2020 and to advertise the project for bid in December, 2020.

ROP-136 Route 17 Bridge Deck Replacement Projects (NJDOT)

Route 17 over Central Avenue

Route 17 Over 2 Railroad Bridges

- Meetings held on October 29, 2018 and January 16, 2019 with NJDOT Officials, Engineering Consultants for NJDOT, Administration, Rochelle Park Police Department and DPW, and our office to review the above project.
- The project involves the replacement of structurally deficient bridge decks over Central Avenue, NYS&W Railroad and railroad spur.

- They are currently in project development phase. Anticipate design and preparation of plans to take 5-6 years to complete.
- Project would not consist of any road widening.
- The NJDOT understands the importance of not disturbing traffic to the greatest extent possible. Are proposing to utilize Accelerated Bridge Construction (ABC) Technologies. Bridge decks would be constructed off-site adjacent to bridge location. The Central Avenue Bridge may require a full closure for one (1) weekend. The Railroad Bridges could require a full closure for two (2) weeks. They would try to coordinate these closures during non-peak travel times. Additional closures of Route 17 and Central Avenue will be required for utility relocation work.
- We anticipate many meetings with the NJDOT in the future as the project progresses.

ROP-149 State Aid Application for Fiscal Year 2020

- Received notification that the Township will receive a Local Aid Grant in the amount of \$186,000.00 for improvements to Oldis Street, from Rochelle Avenue to Route 17.
- We have provided the Township with our proposal dated May 20, 2020 for engineering services.

ROP-163 Marinus Street and 2020 Road, Curb and Sidewalk Program

- Punchlist items expected to be completed by December 12, 2020.

ROP-170 Bergen County's Open Space Trust Fund – 2020 Funding Round

- Township has applied for Barrier Free Ramp at Carlock Field.
- The County is having their Public Hearing for this project's funding on December 10, 2020.

ROP-171 Revaluation and Digitizing of Tax Maps

- It is our understanding that the Township will be undergoing a revaluation in 2021. Currently reviewing recommended revisions with Township Tax Assessor.

ROP-175 NJDOT FY2021 Local Aid Applications

- Grant Application submitted for Improvements to El Dorado Court and Crescent Street.
- On November 16, 2020 the Township received notification from the NJDOT that they have been selected to receive a Grant in the amount of \$189,000.00 for this project.

ROP-178 Berdan Street Sanitary Sewer Improvements

- We reviewed our Sanitary Sewer Report with the Mayor and Township Committee at the meeting held on May 13, 2020.
- Proposal for engineering design services approved at the meeting on June 10, 2020.
- Obtained estimates from contractors for Phase 1 of this project. Township is currently reviewing the proposals received.
- Phase 2 design completed. Draft of plans and specifications provided to the Township on November 12, 2020. Expect this phase of the project to be placed in the 2021 Municipal Budget.

**ROP-179 Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Improvements
(ROP-192)**

- We reviewed our Sanitary Sewer Report with the Mayor and Township Committee at the meeting held on May 13, 2020.
- Our proposal for engineering design services submitted on July 13, 2020. Awaiting approval to proceed with design.
- Township has made initial submission to the New Jersey Water Bank Financing Program and obtained ranking. Awaiting direction from the Township to set up meeting with Program and Township.
- Application submitted to the State for funding as part of FEMA's Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) on November 25, 2020.

**ROP-184 Lincoln Avenue and William Street Curb and Sidewalk Project
(ROP-187)**

- Met with Administrator on August 12, 2020 to review scope of work.
- On August 18, 2020 provided Township with project estimate to be utilized for developing project budget.

- Township submitted Grant Application on November 24, 2020 for consideration through NJDOT's Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program.

ROP-190 GIS Mapping of Storm and Sanitary Sewer Assets

- Received authorization to proceed on November 5, 2020.
- Expect this work to be completed by December 31, 2020.

ROP-191 2021 Bergen County Road Resurfacing Project and Barrier Free Curb Ramp Program

- The County proposes to resurface Essex Street in 2021. The Township will be required to administer a project to bring the barrier free ramps into conformance. This will be reimbursed by the County.
- Proposal for engineering design services submitted on November 9, 2020.
