Dear Mr. Toby,

As the Records Custodian, I received your OPRA request on December 28, 2022. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is January 9, 2023. This response to your request is being provided to you on the seventh (7th) business day after the Township's Records Custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:
List of vacant and abandoned properties

OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

Your request requires an extension of time until Tuesday, January 10, 2023, representing a one (1) business day extension from the original response deadline of January 9, 2023. Extension required due to the Code Enforcement Officer being available tomorrow to provide our office with the requested information.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Logan to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
