This response to your request is being provided to you on the 7th business day the custodian's receipt of said request.

You have requested the following records: 1. does the city / town assign your municipal Liens(Yes) 2.can we have a list of all tax lien Investors (attached) 3.can we have a list of all properties that are in bankruptcy(attached) 4.can we have a list of all properties that have liens on them dating back to 2002 until today(attached) 5.can we have a list of all properties that are in probate (No Records) 6.can we have a list of all vacant and abandoned properties(attached)

These records are being transmitted to you via email, opra+request-38495-87a370e9@requests.opramachine.com as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Swedesboro to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
