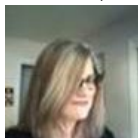

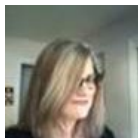

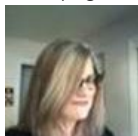

DATED: November 12, 2019**

Resolution Calling for Study Commission to Review the Open Public Records Act

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights strongly believes in and supports open transparent government, and that citizens and residents have the right to be informed about the workings of government in order to best participate in a democracy; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2002 then Acting Governor DiFrancesco signed into law the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) which mandates that government records shall be available, with limited exceptions, for public access and simplifying the procedures for requesting such specific records; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the law was to provide the public with easy access to government records with an uncomplicated process for obtaining the records and eliminating bureaucratic red tape; and

WHEREAS, over the course of 18 years OPRA has been a positive light, but it has also been fraught with abuse and misuse, and has become an unanticipated financial cost to the taxpayers of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights has labored under a well-intended law that has spiraled out of control, due to the volume and nature of requests, the cost to taxpayers in responding to the requests, and the potential liability in having to pay disproportionate prevailing party attorney's fees should the requests turn into litigated matters, as well as the liability in determining which documents shall be released, with or without redaction, while attempting to maintain individual privacy; and

WHEREAS, it is not only the volume of OPRA requests that challenge our resources, but it is also the cost associated with reviewing, retrieving, and processing the OPRA request(s) by public entity personnel and counsel and possibly defending our action(s) before the Government Records Council or in Superior Court; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights received and responded to 165 OPRA requests in 2017, 367 OPRA requests in 2018, and to date has received and responded to 344 OPRA requests as of September 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, with limited exceptions OPRA has not been amended to address the clear and apparent advancement in technology that has changed the way government records are created, stored, and/or transmitted; the various interpretive decisions; privacy concerns; abuse for commercial gain; and/or the ever increasing cost to taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, as the current law approaches its twentieth (20th) anniversary it has outgrown its original intended use and has become ripe for comprehensive review and reform;

Hi Olivia, I'm copying Lori Buckelew, who is our point person on this issue and formerly a municipal clerk. She can speak to more specifics.

I can tell you that concerns being cited in the resolution are ones that we hear statewide and it's certainly a recurrent issue. The concept of a task force goes back to a resolution passed at the League conference in 2018 (see attached). There is legislation to do so...sponsored by Assemblyman Ron Dancer in the Assembly and Senator Corrado in the Senate. To date, neither bill has advanced and we hope to see some advancement in 2020. The resolution that was passed is likely based on a template resolution prepared by the Municipal Clerks Association and in which we have also shared. Lori may be able to pinpoint the number, but the League is copied on the resolutions and they are coming in fast, especially considering they were only distributed last month.

- 2) Is there a fear that some action on OPRA/OPMA reform bills may take place during the "lame duck" session?
- 3) What changes or revisions does the NJ League of Municipalities support?
- 4) Are there any estimates - on the high end and low end - of what the OPRA costs a municipality to handle every year?
- 5) Is there another contact with the NJ Municipal Clerks Association that can provide more details on the effort to form a statewide study commission to examine the OPRA/OPMA laws?

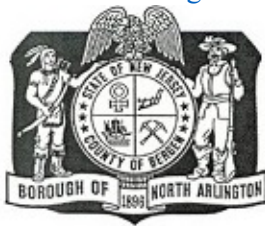
