We hope you can make it.

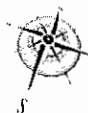

Dear Families of the H.W. Mountz School:

We are writing to address concerns that have come to our attention with regard to the security and safety of our school. Rest assured that the safety of our students and staff remains our highest priority.

As you may know, we have a strong partnership with the Spring Lake Police Department and have an officer stationed in the building on a daily basis.

This is to confirm that despite rumor and innuendo, there have been no threats of violence directed at the school. Any safety concerns that have been brought to our attention have been documented and vetted by both internal and external parties and do not pose any current threat.

We have, unfortunately, become aware of conflicts between parents that escalated over the weekend. We are concerned that parental conflicts may result in exchanges that negatively impact the students and staff while at school. We have alerted the Spring Lake police accordingly, and while it is our hope that these matters do not spill over into the school environment, we must review the extent of parental participation in end of year activities in order to ensure a safe and positive close to the school year.

We request your assistance in supporting the efforts of the staff in continuing to foster the positive and close knit community that is Spring Lake.
