78. Narrative On January 6, 2025, at approximately 2141 hours, I was dispatched to 440 Belleville Turnpike (CVS) in response to a report of a possible shoplifter. Before my arrival, dispatch advised that the individual in question was described as a dark-skinned male wearing a black coat, black pants, and a gray hooded sweater under the coat. Upon arrival, I observed a dark-skinned male matching the description mounting a Vespa-like scooter in front of the CVS main entrance. I approached the individual, later identified as Mr. Lookenso Volmar, and instructed him to dismount and turn off the scooter. I escorted Mr. Volmar to my patrol unit to temporarily detain him until it could be confirmed whether any items had been concealed. While attempting to detain Mr. Volmar with handcuffs, a brief skirmish ensued but was quickly resolved. After being handcuffed, through a slight language barrier of Spanish/Portuguese Mr. Volmar stated that he had already paid for the items in the CVS bag next to him. Beside the bag on the ground was a new pair of winter gloves, which Mr. Volmar claimed he had also purchased. The bag contained body lotions, but no receipt was present for the items. I spoke with CVS employee Ms. Olivia Bredamus, who confirmed that Mr. Volmar had paid for the body lotions but had not paid for the winter gloves. CVS management agreed that if Mr. Volmar paid for the gloves, they would not

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pursue charges but requested that he be trespassed from the store. Mr. Volmar complied by paying for the gloves and acknowledged that he was no longer permitted to return to CVS.

Ms. Bredamus further informed me that the aisle where Mr. Volmar had been observed does not have surveillance cameras. However, she found the gloves' packaging on the floor in that aisle. She also stated that she had witnessed Mr. Volmar stuffing the gloves into his pants before proceeding to pay for the lotions.

No further police action was taken at this time.
