NARRATIVE

On Monday January 20, 2025 I responded to the Krausz's food store located at 1886 RT 130 for the theft of bread during overnight hours of Saturday January 18, 2025.

Upon arrival I met with Dipak Patel who informed me he has the theft on video. Upon watching the video I was able to identify the suspect vehicle as NJ: Y64MLK which Carlos Dasilva has been known to operate. Upon further viewing the video it was determined that the suspect was in fact Carlos Dasilva a possible former bread vendor of Krasuzers. Dasilva can be seen parking his vehicle in front of the store at 0331 hrs, exiting, removing a box of delivered bread from in front of the establishment, placing it inside of his vehicle, and departing the area. Patel further advised me the bread and it's box were worth a total of \$70. The theft also negatively impacted the business during it's busiest hours as they had no bread to provide to their customers for approximately three hours.

The CCTV footage was collected and logged into Command Central Evidence.

Complaint warrant was approved by the Honorable Municipal Court Judge Christine Heitmann 1215W2025000045 for 2C:20-3A.

As of the writing of this report Dasilva has not been taken into custody.

No notes were taken and there is nothing further at this time.
