NARRATIVE

On 1/15/25 I was dispatched to Target of North Brunswick (101 Grand Ave) on a shoplifter in custody.

Upon arrival I spoke with Loss Prevention Specialist, Anthony

Nishimura, who relayed his team recognized defendant Garrison Bryant Jr from a previous shoplifting event which was reported but the defendant never apprehended or charged, see report #24-059848. Today, when the defendant entered Target, Loss Prevention recognized him from the prior incident and followed his movements in the store. The defendant was observed selecting various items from the Grocery department and concealed items in his jacket pockets. The defendant then passed the final point of sale and exited the store without rendering payment for the items. Defendant was then confronted and stopped outside by loss prevention and advised him he was under arrest for shoplifting to which he complied and returned with loss prevention staff back in the store without incident.

Police were then called and responded. Defendant was positively identified and advised he would be placed under arrest for shoplifting. Total Items for today's incident was valued at \$30.64. Defendant was then handcuffed, checking for proper fit and double locked for his safety.

Defendant was then placed in the back of my patrol vehicle, 555, and transported to headquarters without incident. Prior to placing defendant in my patrol vehicle, the passenger compartment was checked for contraband/weapons with negative results. At Police HQ, defendant was processed, photographed and fingerprinted. He was then issued a copy of his summons advised of his court date and released.

Today's evidence was logged and entered by Officer Marius. It should be noted that this Officer was not presented with the video evidence of the prior incident (24-059848) to charge defendant with that crime.
