NARRATIVE

On January 15th, 2024, at approximately 1544 hours, I (Ptl.Benanti) responded to 979 Route 1, Walmart, for the report of a shoplifting that occurred fifteen minutes in the past.

Upon arrival, I spoke with loss prevention, Carlos Bermudez, who advised

two unknown suspects entered the store and left with two shopping carts full of merchandise. On surveillance video I observed the male and female suspects push two over filled shopping carts past all points of sale. It appeared the Gain and Tide laundry detergent products were concealed under the Bounty paper products. Bermudez provided an approximate value of \$412.22 in merchandise that the suspects did not pay for. Both suspects entered through the garden section at 1526 hours and left through the Home & Pharmacy doors at 1534 hours.

The first suspect appears to be a male wearing tan pants, olive colored jacket, and a dark colored winter hat. The second suspect appears to be a female wearing a black jacket, dark colored pants, black head and face covering, and had a cell phone case with a green or yellow circle on the back.

Bermudez provided a disc containing the surveillance video. The disc was entered into the B.E.A.S.T evidence system. A training receipt and pictures of the suspects were submitted to the case file.
