Please be advised that you are excluded from the next two (2) Council Meetings on November 14, 2022 and November 22, 2022. In accordance with the listed Newark Municipal Council's Code of Conduct governing acceptable behavior during official City business (attached for your review), we are officially notifying you of the reasons for your ejection from the Regular Meeting held on Wednesday, November 2, 2022, which resulted in your exclusion from the next two (2) meetings.

As you are aware, Council President McIver advised you on multiple occasions that your continued outbursts and behavior during the meeting were not only rude, disruptive and a distraction to the proceedings, they were selfish and extremely disrespectful to the rights of other residents in attendance. Accordingly, Council President McIver exercised the authority of her office, and directed the Sergeant-at-Arms to comply with her request for your prompt removal. The Council President's prudent decision afforded other members of the public the opportunity to voice their concerns and opinions with civil discourse and discussion on important City business without unwarranted distractions and interruptions.

Going forward, we are hopeful your disruptive behavior and emotional outbursts are contained so you too can continue to participate in the democratic process and exercise your constitutional right of free speech.
