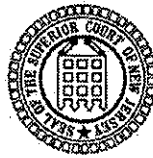

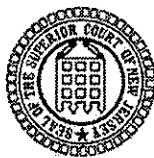

REASONS FOR GRANTING PRETRIAL DETENTION:

FURTHER, for the reasons set forth on the record and herein, the court finds by clear and convincing evidence that no amount of monetary bail, non-monetary conditions or combination of monetary bail and conditions would reasonably assure the defendant's appearance in court when required, the protection of the safety of any other person or the community, that the defendant will not obstruct or attempt to obstruct the criminal justice process.

In reaching this decision, the court made the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

- ❖ The nature and circumstances of the offense charged.
 - Offense(s) charges, specifically, assault on police officer, failed to refrain from alcohol and excessive narcotics, failed to refrain from inappropriate contact with law enforcement, disarming police officer, obstruction, resisting arrest, criminal mischief and throwing bodily fluid at law enforcement
 - Particular circumstances, specifically, disarming police officer and failing to refrain from inappropriate contact with law enforcement
- ❖ The weight of the evidence against the defendant, considering the admissibility of any evidence sought to be excluded.
 - Personal observation of law enforcement officer(s), specifically, disarming police officer and failing to refrain from inappropriate contact with law enforcement
- ❖ The history and characteristics of the defendant, including the defendant's:
 - Criminal history as reflected in the PSA
- ❖ At the time of offense or arrest, the defendant was on the following:
 - Other release pending trial, sentencing, appeal or completion of sentence for offense(s), specifically, Level 3 Pretrial monitoring
- ❖ The nature and seriousness of the danger to any other person or the community that would be posed by the defendant's release, specifically, disarming police officer and failing to refrain from inappropriate contact with law enforcement

The Court granted the Motion to Detain and followed the Public Safety Assessment recommendation of no release for the following reasons and reasons placed on the record:

The Defendant is before the Court for a Detention hearing for 10 current charges.

The Defendant's current charges are of a violent nature as the Defendant assaulted a police officer, disarmed a police officer, resisted arrest and threw bodily fluid at law enforcement

The PSA recommends no release.

The Defendant was on Level 3 Pretrial Monitoring in Ocean County at the time of the alleged offense.

The Defendant has 6 pending charges at the time of this offense. The charges are for disorderly persons resisting arrest, disorderly persons criminal mischief, disorderly persons refusal to submit to fingerprinting, disorderly persons simple assault.

The Defendant was on probation at the time of the alleged offense.

Therefore, the motion for pretrial detention is **GRANTED**. The defendant is hereby **ORDERED**
