DISPATCHED FOR REPORT OF SMOKE FROM THE ROOF. E10, E14, E16, T12, U15, B19, 101 AND NUMEROUS MUTUAL AID ALL RESPONDED. CREWS FOUND WORKING FIRE ON FLOORS 10 AND 12, WITH EXTENSION ONTO ROOF A/C SHAFTS. FIRE CONTAINED TO FL 10 AND FL 12 STORAGE ROOMS. FIRE PREVENTION ON SCENE FOR FIRE INVESTIGATION AND FIRE WATCH. VFD, VRS, VPD AND NUMEROUS MUTUAL AID PARTICIPATED IN EVACUATION OF WEST SIDE OF THE BUILDING DUE TO POWER LOSS. SCENE TURNED OVER TO VERONA OEM, VERONA PD, AND VERONA FIRE PREVENTION AFTER VFD CLEARED.
