Dear Mr. Toby:

The County of Salem received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on August 7, 2023. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is June 16, 2023. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 6th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"Please provide the following a list of all property owners name and address that have been foreclosed and have any surplus funds available. Please provide the amounts that are available as well."

The records that you are requesting are being denied based on the following:

No responsive records exist to fulfill this request. Any surplus foreclosure funds are turned over to the State and never held by the Sheriff's Office.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Salem to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
