

Body Worn Recorder Classifications

Every Officer is equipped with a Body Worn Recorder (BWR). For Patrol, the following classifications will be programed into the BWR.

1. Privacy – This category should be used for medical calls and other calls requiring private circumstances.
2. Traffic Stop – This category should be used for any Motor Vehicle Stop (Excluding DWI)
3. Arrest/Transportation – This category should be used for an arrest on warrants or disorderly person offenses. It should also be used for transportation of civilians.
4. Domestic Violence – This category should be used for verbal domestic disputes, child custody disputes, and incidents of Domestic Violence.
5. DWI – This category should be used for any DWI Arrests.
6. Indictable Crime- This category should be used for any Indictable Crimes (Excluding Domestic Violence).
7. MVA – This category should involve all Motor Vehicle Accidents (Excluding DWI).
8. Mental Health Emergency – This category should be used for any Mental Health related incidents.
9. Motor Vehicle Complaints – This category should be used for blocked driveways, 48 hour violations, and parking offenses.
10. Investigation – This should be used for an incident that does not fall into the above categories. An example would be a neighbor dispute or customer dispute. This should also be used by supervisors completing Taser Function Tests.

Special Circumstances:

In the event of a Use of Force situation or a Pursuit the Officer shall log into the website for the BWR and tag the event as UOF or Pursuit. The same procedure shall be adhered to for a Show Up Identification. For example, if there is a Robbery and a Show Up Identification is conducted the Officer must log into the BWR website and categorize the classification as BOTH Indictable Crime AND Show Up ID.

Instructions for Classifying from the BWR

1. After stopping a recording press the DISP. Button on the top of the BWR to scroll through the menu until you reach the category tab.



2. You will see the Category Tab as one of the categories listen below with a Paperclip Icon



3. If the category that appears is the desired category then press the FUNC button



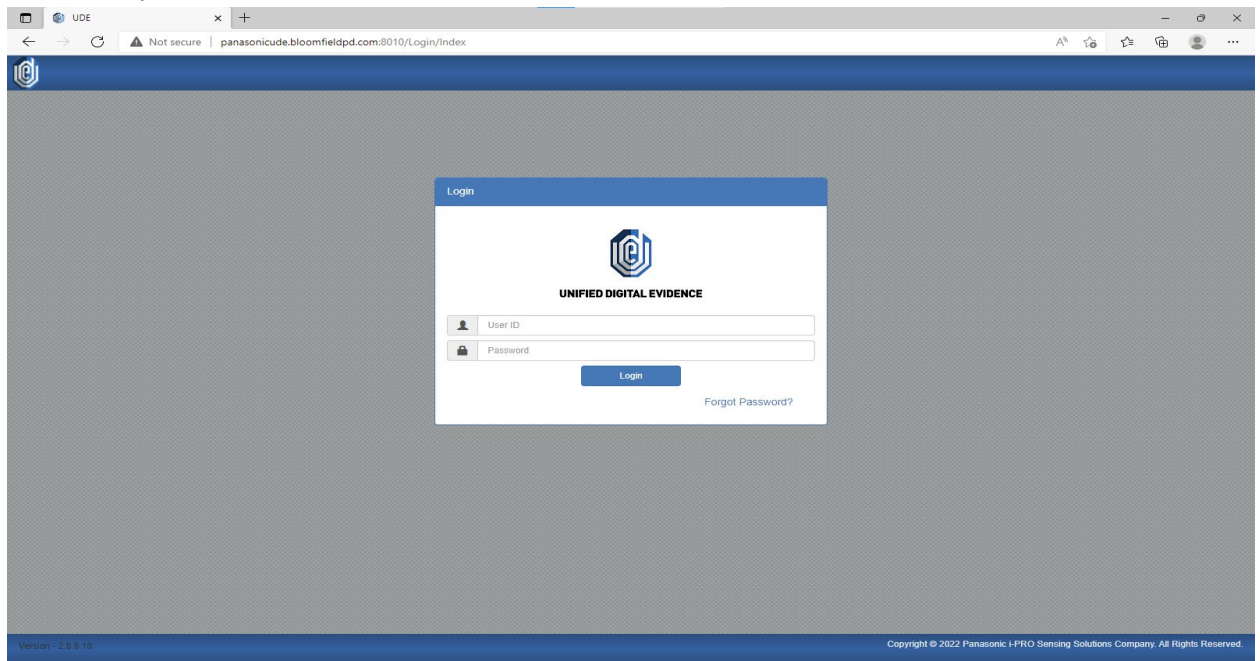
4. The FUNC button will remove the Paperclip Icon.



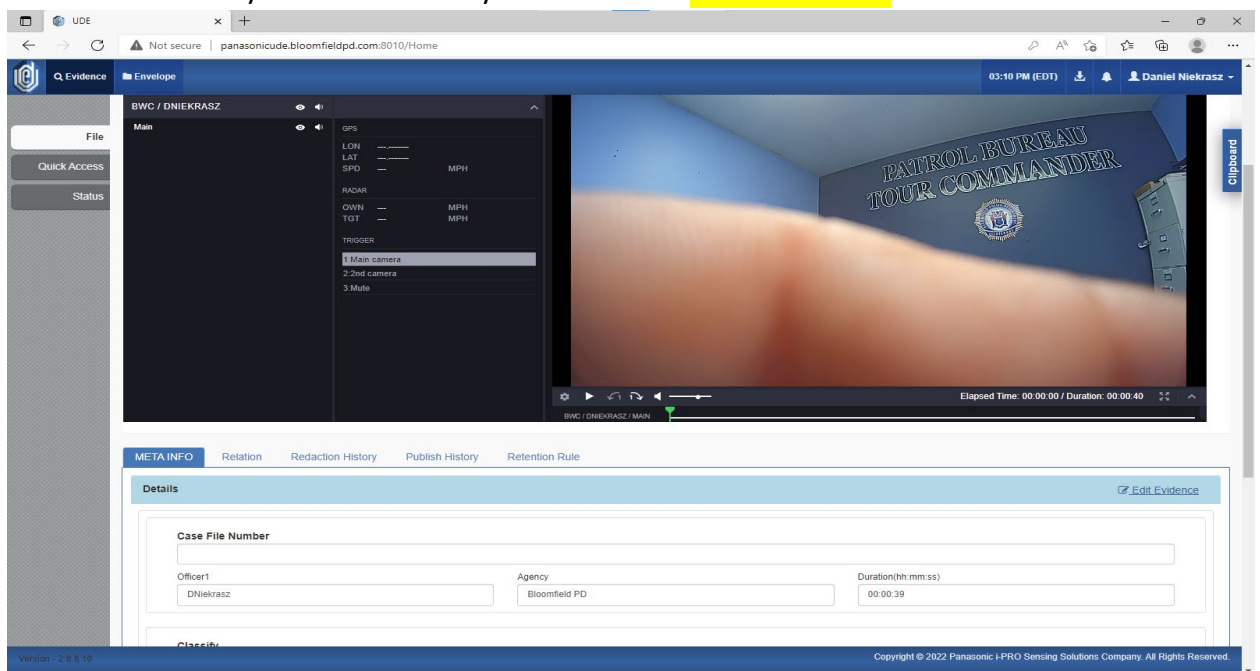
5. Press the FUNC button again to classify the recording.
- In the event that the desired classification is not listed when you initially scroll through then stop at whichever classification is displayed with the Paperclip Icon and hold the DISP button. This will remove the Paperclip Icon. Press the DISP. Button to scroll through the above listed classifications to choose the appropriate classification. Hold down the DISP. Button to select the proper classification and then follow steps 3 to 5 listed above.

Classification of BWR recordings from the website

1. Visit <http://panasonicude.bloomfieldpd.com:8010/Login/Index> and login with Lawsoft Username/Password



2. Click on the video you wish to classify. Then Click on **"Edit Evidence"**



3. Select the Proper Classification under Classify and press Update
