Dear Ben,

The Manchester Utilities Authority ("MUA") received your original Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 17, 2020. The official Records Custodian, Denise Wahad, received your OPRA request on that same date. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is July 28, 2020. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 3rd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following information relevant to the MUA and its operations:

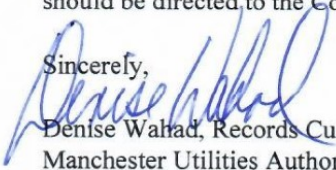
1. "All properties with delinquent water which date back up to 1 year, including amounts owed"; and
2. "All properties currently listed with water shut-off notice."

The MUA has conducted a search of its records and the response to the above requests are as follows:

1. From July 16, 2019 through July 16, 2020, the MUA has 1,007 delinquent water accounts. As requested, an excel spreadsheet summary of those accounts including the amounts owed is provided herein.
2. There are currently no properties listed for water shut-off.

There is no charge for this request since you requested it in electronic format. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the MUA to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
