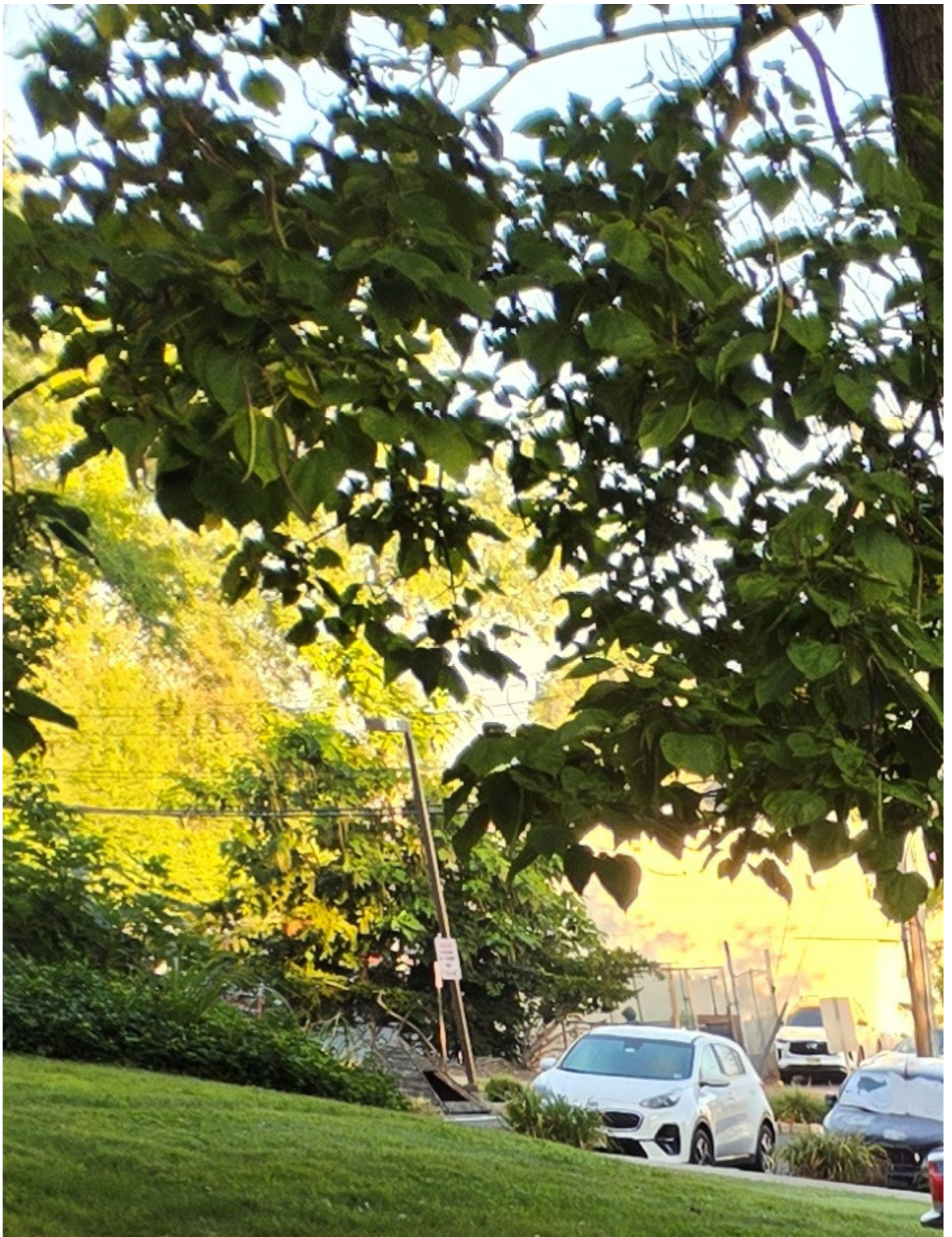

Good morning,

I just wanted to notify you that there are multiple vehicles that have been parking alongside the grass area during the day and overnight. The bigger issue is that they're not even parking close to the sidewalk, they are now more into the parking area which is effecting cars from pulling in and out of their parking spots. Pictured is the white vehicle that has been here overnight. Other times there is a black vehicle, burgundy truck, and another white vehicle parked here as well. That's about 3 to 4 vehicles parked there at a time.

There have been multiple occasions where the men in these vehicles have stared at tenants walking to and from their vehicles and the entryway which causes uncomfort. Also, they are littering on the premises and smoking marijuana. For example, during a barbecue Saturday held by tenant Lisa in the B Building, a water bottle was placed on the table outside of my apartment. When I came outside to remove it, she it had been placed back on my table.

Is it possible that there can be some type of email blast to Weaver Street tenants letting everyone know that parking is available on the street and if they leave overnight park and they should contact the summit Police Department, because this is getting out of hand!



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
