Students could move about the building but could not leave until the shelter-in-place was lifted. The shelter-in-place was lifted at 12:45 PM once the person making the post was with the Monroe Police, and the threat was deemed not credible. I want to thank the students and staff for their cooperation, and we appreciate the assistance of the Monroe Township Police Department.
