RESOLUTION NO. 2026 – 117

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STAFFORD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THAT THE \$94 MILLION INCREASE IN STATE AID IN THE FY 2027 STATE BUDGET BE FAIRLY DISTRIBUTED TO ALL MUNICIPALITIES

WHEREAS, for the past 30 years, the State’s budgets have either cut or held municipal funding flat; and

WHEREAS, each year, Trenton claims there simply is not enough funding available to provide even a modest cost-of-living adjustment to help support local budgets and control property taxes; and

WHEREAS, that claim from Trenton has been, at times, disingenuous, as the State’s rapidly growing annual budgets have included various expenditures while municipal aid has remained stagnant; and

WHEREAS, the State budget proposed by Governor Sherrill on March 10th includes a \$94 million proposed increase in “Transitional Aid” for a limited number of municipalities that routinely request special State assistance; and

WHEREAS, many municipalities, including the Township of Stafford, work diligently to responsibly balance their budgets while continuing to face rising costs associated with inflation, healthcare, and essential services; and

WHEREAS, while some municipalities receiving Transitional Aid may have legitimate financial needs, others have faced challenges stemming from fiscal decisions that place additional strain on statewide resources; and

WHEREAS, equitable distribution of State aid would provide meaningful support to all municipalities striving to maintain fiscal responsibility while continuing to serve their residents effectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Stafford, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Township of Stafford respectfully requests that:
 - a. Governor Sherrill support reallocating the \$94 million proposed increase in municipal aid to all municipalities that are grappling with challenges including high

inflation, extraordinary increases in health benefits costs, and prior cuts in State aid;
and

- b. the New Jersey State League of Municipalities advocate on behalf of all municipalities by supporting a more equitable distribution of additional municipal aid; and
- c. the members of the New Jersey Legislature adopt a budget that allocates all municipal aid increases fairly and equitably.

2. A copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted to Governor Sherrill, the New Jersey State League of Municipalities, and each member of the New Jersey Legislature representing the Township of Stafford.

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Stafford, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the “Township”) has solicited electronic bids for the Furnishing and Delivery of Regulatory Signs to the Township of Stafford, Lead Agency for the Stafford Township Cooperative Pricing System and Cooperative Members (hereinafter referred to as the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, two (2) electronic bid proposals were received on March 4, 2026 in response to the public advertisement for electronic Bid #2026-03-STCO from National Highway Products, Inc. and Blink Marketing Inc.; and

WHEREAS, National Highway Products, Inc. was the lowest bidder in the amount of \$178,403.55, which represents the total base bid, inclusive of Sections I, II and III; and

WHEREAS, the bid documentation submitted by National Highway Products, Inc. has been reviewed for compliance with the Local Public Contracts Law, Rules and Supplemental Laws, by the Township's Qualified Purchasing Agent and the Township Solicitor and found to be acceptable as to form and content; and

WHEREAS, the participating units in the Stafford Township Cooperative Pricing System who supplied their estimated quantities that each registered member proposes to contract for during the life of the master contract for the furnishing and delivery of Regulatory Signs are

Barneгат Township, Beach Haven Borough, Beachwood Borough, Berkeley Township, Howell Township, Jackson Township, Lacey Township, Lakewood Township, Long Beach Township, Ocean Township (Waretown), Pine Beach Borough, Pinelands Regional School District, Ship Bottom Borough, Southern Regional High School District, Stafford Township School District, as well as, the Township of Stafford (Lead Agency); and

WHEREAS, National Highway Products, Inc. did not list any exceptions in their submitted bid proposal; and

WHEREAS, National Highway Products, Inc. has agreed to provide the items and pricing listed in their bid proposal to participating Stafford Cooperative Purchasing Members; and

WHEREAS, the award of the contract to National Highway Products, Inc. is in compliance with the Township's budgetary constraints.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this **31st day of March, 2026** by the Township Council of the Township of Stafford, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Township hereby awards the contract for itself and as the Lead Agency for the Stafford Township Cooperative Pricing System for the purchase and delivery of Regulatory Signs to National Highway Products, Inc., having its principal offices and BRC address located at 301 Riverside Drive, Millville, NJ 08332 as per Schedule A attached shall not exceed \$200,000.00 for contract year one, and \$200,000.00 for contract year two.

2. The contract for the purchase and delivery of Regulatory Signs for the Township is an open-ended contract and shall be in effect for twenty-four (24) consecutive months. The term of the contract will be from April 26, 2026 through April 25, 2028.

3. The Township reserves the right to include provisions for an extension to the contract with the vendor's agreement. If the Township desires to extend a contract under the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15, the index rate is the basis to determine the appropriate increase in the contract price. The extension will be for a one (1) two-year extension or two (2) one-year extensions as per the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

4. The Township authorizes and directs the Mayor, the Township Administrator and the Township Clerk to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this Resolution.

5. No purchases shall be made under this Contract until the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for such purchases.

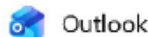

Stafford Township and Act Engineers have authorized Spectraserv to change the method of dredging on this project from Hydraulic Dredging with temporary relocation for dewatering at Lot 56.07 to Mechanical Dredging with barge transport to and offloading across the bulkhead at the northeast end of William Cook Blvd Manahawkin, NJ on the west side of the canal.

Spectraserv agrees that the spoils will be offloaded from the barge via long reach excavator placed on land adjacent to the bulkhead and loaded directly into dump trucks and or roll off trucks for road transport to the disposal area. No changes have been made to the final disposal location.

The trucks are required to have a watertight seal and double toggle locks on the tailgate, and the material will be loaded in the truck no more than 16" below the sideboard or top of the truck body. All reasonable precautions will be taken to eliminate spillage onto the roadways and private property. A request has been made to install dash cams in the haul trucks to record any possible incidents along the roadway.

Spectraserv has agreed to photograph and video the dock and bulkhead area at low tide to confirm existing condition as well as the landward side of the dock/bulkhead area and pavement.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STAFFORD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-48 FOR THE WATER/SEWER UTILITY

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen on February 11, 2026 with respect to a Township public water main underneath the Route 72 NJDOT bridge that extends from Ship Bottom to Cedar Bonnet Island burst due to severe freezing conditions. Emergency repairs/replacement of the water main are required to ensure the Township can provide safe drinking water to the residents of Cedar Bonnet Island in Stafford Township. No adequate provision was made in the 2026 temporary budget for the aforesaid purpose, nor the time exists to wait for the adoption of a capital ordinance to provide said funding, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-46 provides for the creation on an emergency appropriation for the purpose mentioned above, and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the emergency appropriations created, including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is \$1,000,000.00 and three (3) percent of the total current and utility operating appropriations in the final budget for 2025 is \$1,725,745.25 and

WHEREAS, the foregoing appropriation together with prior appropriations does not exceed three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations (including utility operation appropriations) in the budget for 2025,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, (by not less than 2/3 of all governing body members affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-48:

1. An emergency appropriation is hereby made for the Water/Sewer Utility Operating Fund for Repair/Replacement of Water Main underneath the Route 72 NJDOT bridge that extends from Ship Bottom to Cedar Bonnet Island in the amount of \$1,000,000.00
2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in full in the 2026 budget.
3. That two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services
