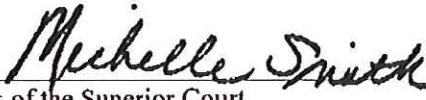

A telephone call will not protect your rights; you must file and serve a written answer or motion (with fee of \$175.00 and completed Case Information Statement) if you want the court to hear your defense.

If you do not file and serve a written answer or motion within 35 days, the court may enter a judgment against you for the relief plaintiff demands, plus interest and costs of suit. If judgment is entered against you, the Sheriff may seize your money, wages or property to pay all or part of the judgment.

On August 11th, 2014 at approximately 9:50PM, I arrived home to a fire in my home.

I called 911, The fire department arrived and Teaneck police officers arrived.

My Son and I were asked several questions.

For a period of three hours, I calmly answered every question that was asked of me. Informing the my family and I had lived in this home for 21 years.

After a couple of hours went by was asked to sign papers by James Costella, a detective from the Bergen County Prosecutors office (along with another gentlemen from the Bergen County's prosecutors office who's name I do not know.) When I asked what the papers were for, I was told I just needed to sign for procedural purposes to enter my home. I offered to bring the officers into my home and they insisted I could not. Nor could I enter my home and I just needed to wait.

The questioning continued asking a variety of questions, including

"Why are you so calm, while your house is on fire," by officer Annatori

When I responded, I've lost my mother and sister to cancer, my brother to murder and that material things can be replaced. The officer snickered. And the questioning continued.

.....

I waited outside of my home for hours, sitting inside of my car.

At approximately 250AM, Detective James Costello, came to my car and proceeded to open my driver's door. He said, "Not only do I have a warrant to search your home, I also have one to take your phone, give it to me."

As I reached for my phone, He grabbed me and physically threw me across the street, slamming my head on my neighbor's car hood. I was in total shock.

He proceeded to say "get her", at which time a minimum of four police officers grabbed my arms, legs and I was swung in the middle of the street . With my dress and heels on that I had on since leaving early in the morning going to work. I was handcuffed and pushed, up against the car again.

Detective Costello, said, WHO HAS A KNIFE ??

An officer responded that he had one, and I that moment, I thought I was going to be stabbed in my back, I screamed. The knife was placed against my shoulder and my purse that was on my shoulder, was cut off.

Officer Glenn Coley had arrived on the scene and he recognized me.

He asked the officers, what was going on,

A response of "Did We F#%K Up" ?? came from one of the officers.

Officer Coley proceeded to tell them, I was a community leader, law abiding, well known, long term resident of teaneck.

At that time, I was placed in the patrol car and transported to Teaneck Police Department.

At no time was I given an explanation of why I was being arrested, and subsequently, my rights were not read to me.

When I arrived at the police department I was informed I would receive a summons for disorderly conduct and be released.

Once at the precinct, I was placed in a cell for a period of three hours.

When Detective Costello came into the cell at approximately 650AM, I asked him why he would do such a thing to me ?? His response was, "I didn't know what you were reaching for ?" He told me I was free to go. As I walked out of the cell, he said "OH, we have to book and process you first."

I was finger printed, photographed and given paperwork, that indicated, that 5ft 125lbs, in heels and a dress, assaulted four police officers and resisted arrest. I was given a court date and told I could then leave.

Again, I was in shock. When I asked where my things were (My Pocketbook) I was told it was probably still at my house in my car. I walked a mile to my home. Still in disbelief. When I arrived, my car was locked and my purse was not there.

.....

When I went back to the precinct, I was told they were changing shifts and no one could help me.

Outside of the precinct, I recognized officer Jim Crowley, I asked if he would be so kind as to go inside and check where my belongings were. He returned, informing me that my things were at the Bergen County's prosecutors office in Paramus.

By this time, I was in contact with my family. The internet published my arrest, and all of my clients were aware calling my office.

Once I arrived at the Prosecutors office, Lt. Gary Allmars accompanied, Detective James Costella, handed me my pocket book, and said, "There was a significant amount of cash in there, however, we found the bank receipt as well." My purse was returned.

I again, asked Detective James Costello Why he did what he did, and Mr. Allmars said, if I had a problem I needed to contact Asst. Marty Delaney at (201)646-2300.

In addition, the next day, my son was picked up and brought to teaneck police department, his phone was confiscated and he left. (As of today 8/12/16, we have not received the telephones that were confiscated on that night.)

I would later find out from my insurance adjuster Mr. Richard Perez of North Jersey Public Adjusters, that the Bergen county prosecutors office Detective Costello as well as some of the officer, were his friends and had been previous clients of his.

He shared, that Detective James Costella, admitted he was "little rough" and he was transferred out of the unit. In all of the paperwork I received, Detective James Costella, name does not appear anywhere.

On October 28th, 2014, I received a dismissal order signed by Hon. Liliana DeAvila-Silebi for all charges.

On December 7, 2015, I received an order of expungement.

I have since, taken courses on Crisis Intervention training.

As an educated, African American women in my community, I have been an advocate for our youth, and Support all of our local initiatives. I am a very level headed, noncontroversial person.

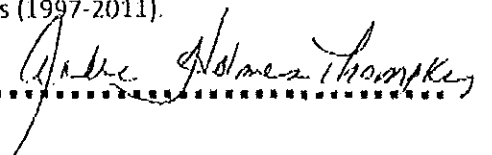
I am a founding Board Member of Teaneck Comes Together

Arson investigation under way at Teaneck home; owner accused of assaulting three officers

TEANECK -- Authorities are investigating an arson at a single-family home on Greenwood Road on Monday night where the homeowner is charged with assaulting three police officers, police said.

No one has been charged with the arson, Lt. Tom Tully said.

Authorities were called around 10:15 p.m. Monday night when the two occupants of the house, including the homeowner, arrived home and went into the garage and saw smoke, according to Lt. Martin Brown, a township fire prevention officer.

The fire, at 867 Greenwood Road, was declared to be a case of arson by the township's fire department, police detectives and the county prosecutor's office, Tully said. It was under control within a half-hour, Brown said.

The homeowner, Andrea Holmes-Thompkins, 51, is charged with three counts of aggravated assault on a police officer, resisting arrest and obstruction or interfering with an investigation, Tully said. She was given summonses and released.

She allegedly kicked two police officers and struck another; none suffered any injuries, Tully said.

The arson is under investigation, he said.

The single-alarm fire was contained to the home's second floor, Brown said. No firefighters or civilians were injured, but the house's two occupants were displaced.

Fire crews from Bogota, Englewood and Hackensack also responded to the scene, he said.

The cause of the fire is under investigation, and Brown said he could not say why it was declared an arson.

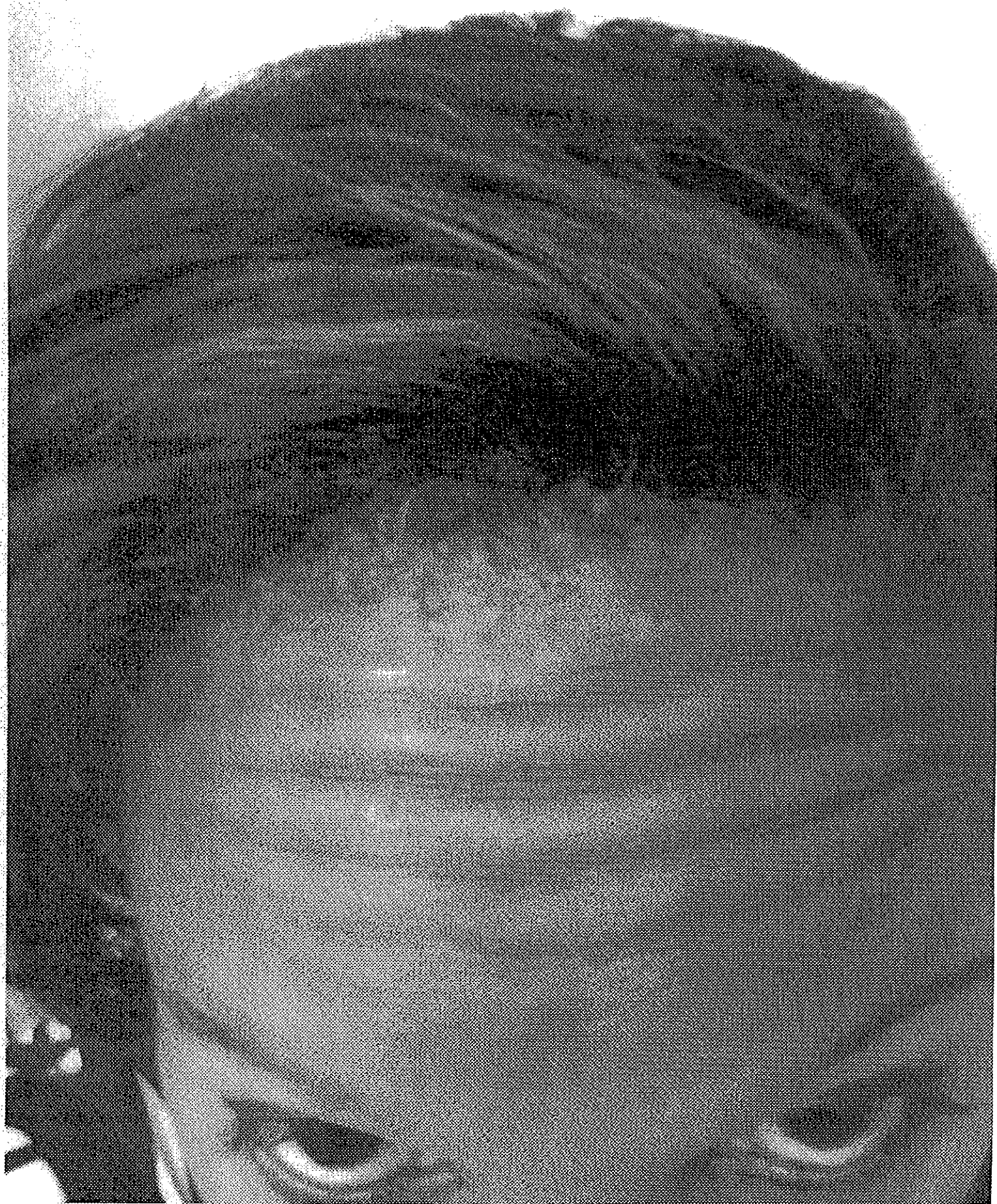
Police do not have a suspect in the arson, Teaneck police Detective Sgt. Kevin Marrero said. "We're attempting to develop a suspect and/or suspects," he said.

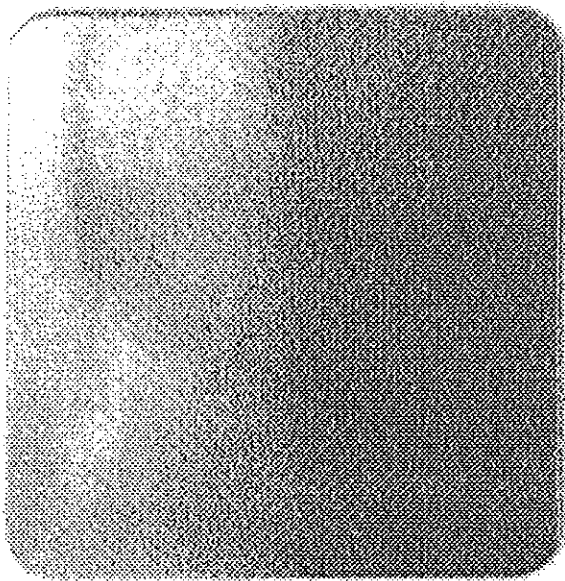
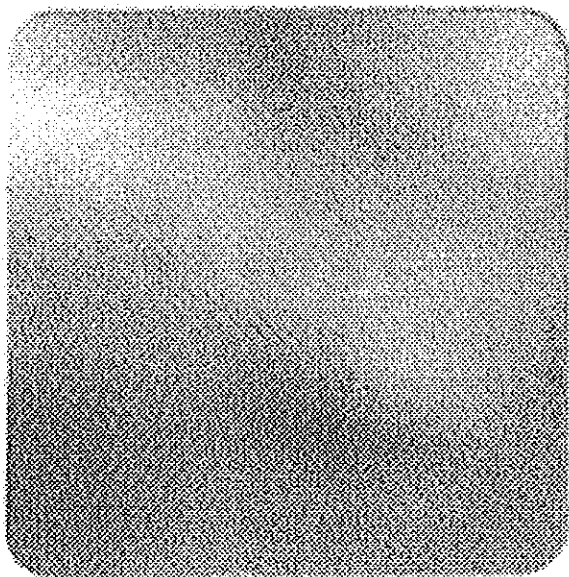
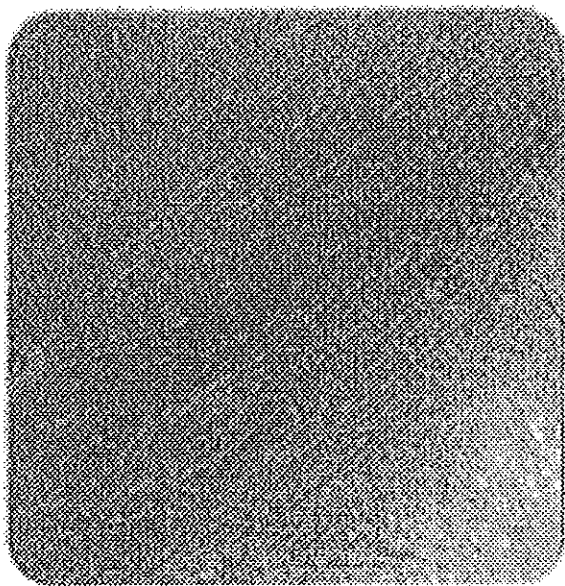
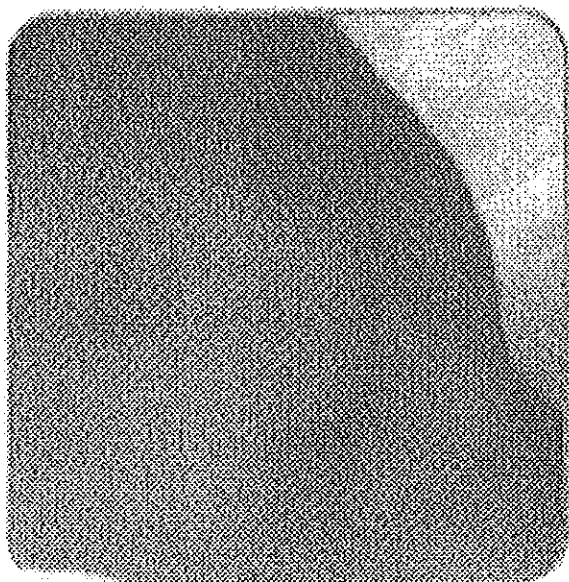
The alleged assault occurred at the scene, Marrero said. He would not give further details on the arson investigation or the alleged assault.



Teaneck has declared an overnight fire at this home an arson. No one has been charged.

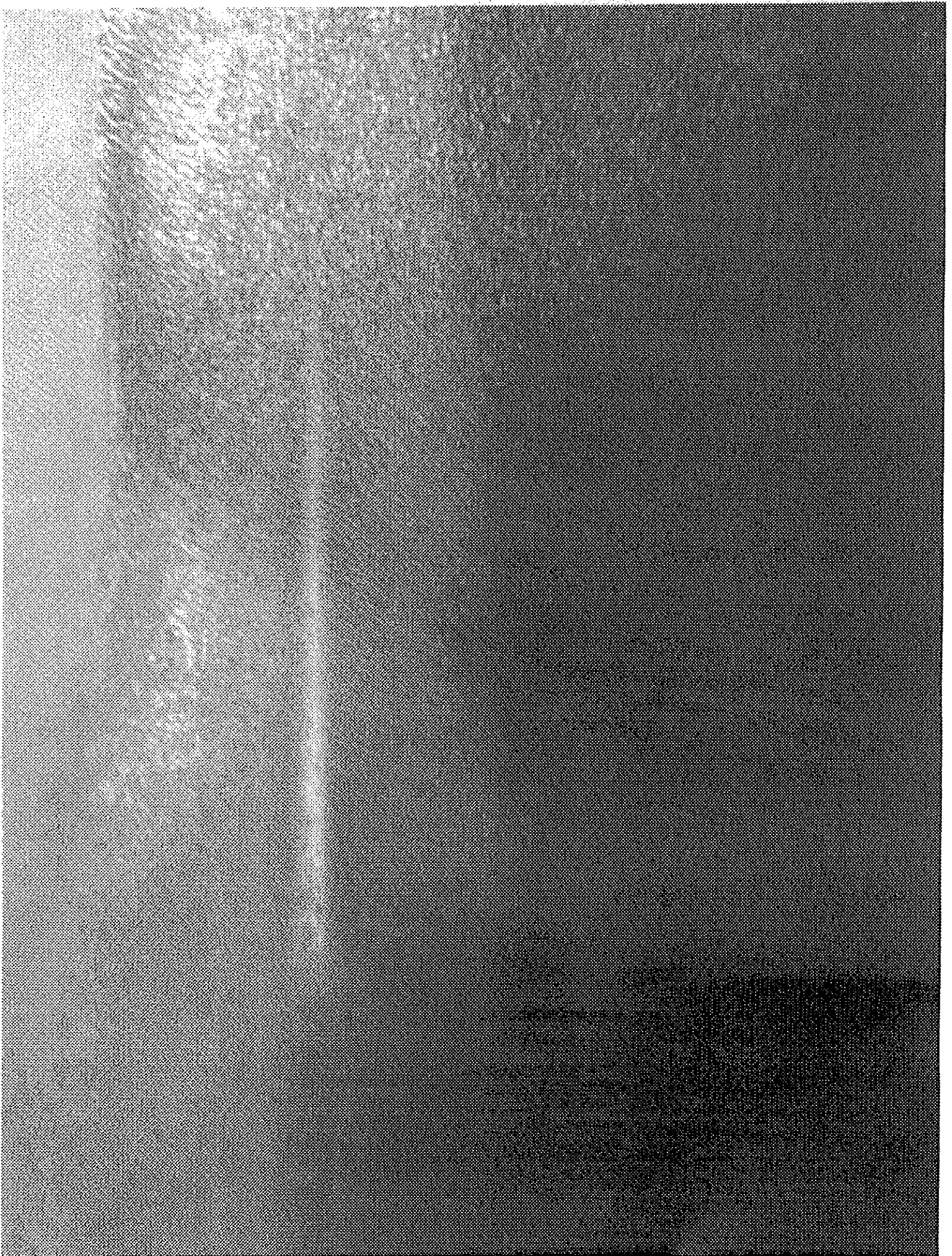
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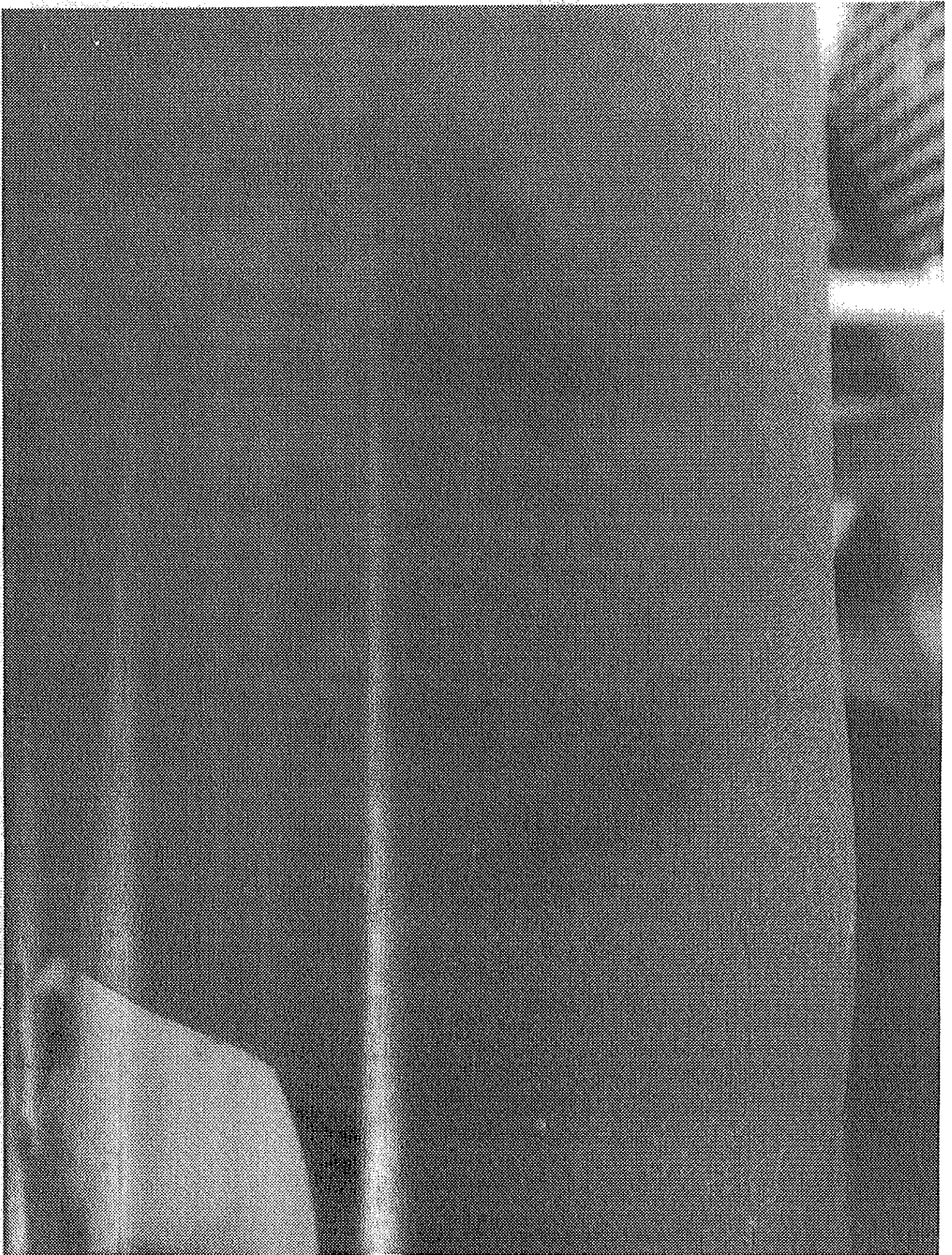




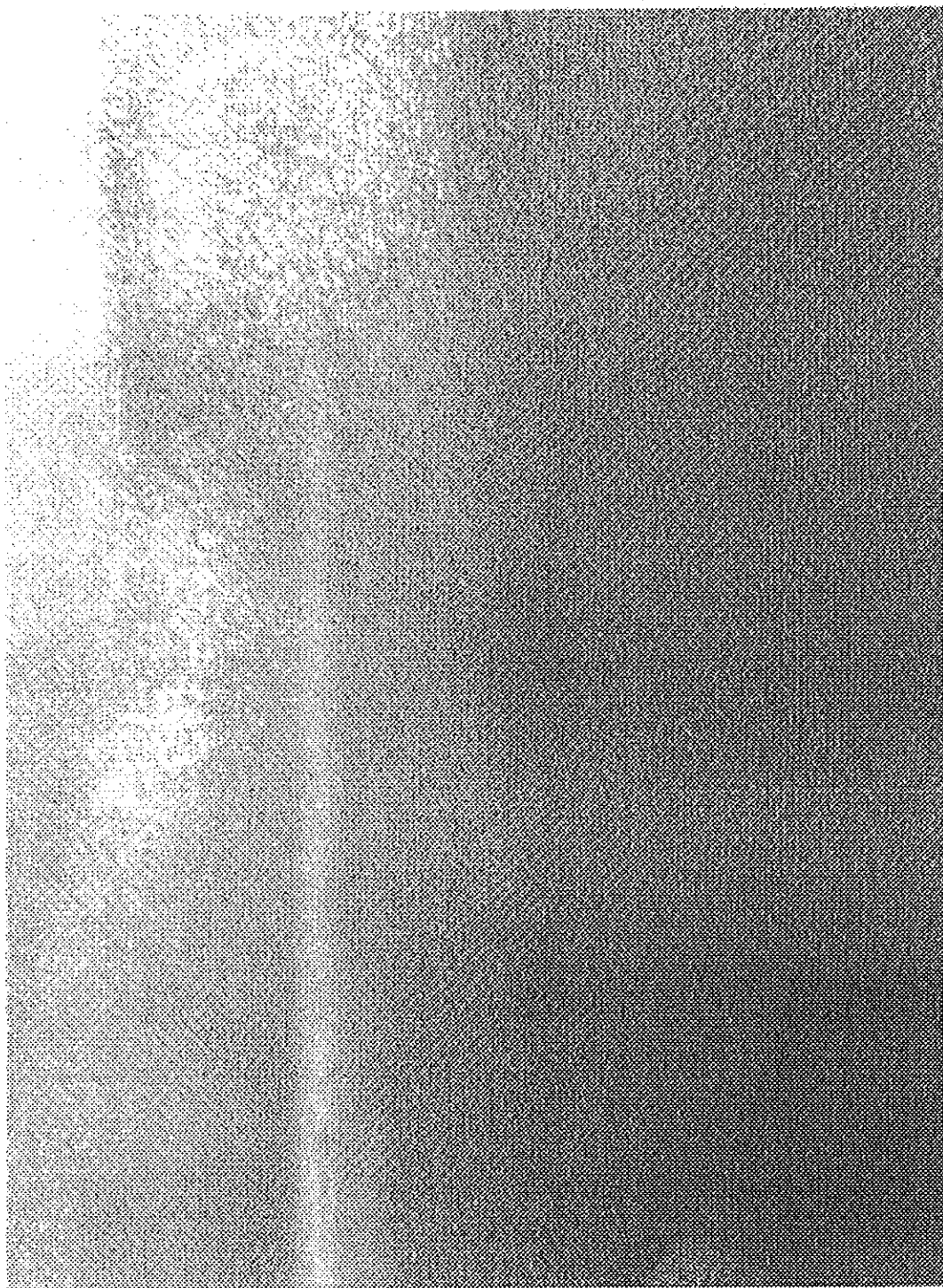

DeAvila-Silebi, P.J.S.C., including but not limited to photographs, fingerprints, rap sheets, index or docket entries, reports (including lab reports) and statements, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:52-15, and shall remove from its records all such information and shall place such information in the control of a person designated to retain control over expunged records; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that any records or file which is maintained by a judicial or law enforcement agency, or agency in the criminal justice system, which is the subject of an order of expungement which includes the name or names of persons other than that of the petitioner, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:52-16, need not be isolated from the general files of the agency retaining same if the other person named in said record or file have not been granted an order of expungement of said record, provided that a copy of the record shall be given to the person designated to retain control over expunged records and the original shall remain in the agencies general files with the petitioners name and other personal identifiers obliterated and deleted; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any records or information removed from court of law enforcement agency records pursuant to this Order shall be deemed **EXPUNGED**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the expunged records or the information therein shall not be released for any reason except as authorized by law, and that the person designated to retain control over expunged records shall take sufficient precaution to insure that such records and information are not released, except as authorized by law; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that except where otherwise authorized by law, in

response to requests for information or records, the court or the law enforcement agency shall reply with respect to the arrest and conviction which is the subject of this Order, that there is no record; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the arrest and conviction which is the subject of this Order shall be deemed not to have occurred, and the petitioner may answer accordingly any question relating to its occurrence; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:52-31, that this Order does not expunge records contained in the Controlled Dangerous Substances Registry created pursuant to P.L. 1970, c. 227 (c.26:2G-17 et seq.), or the registry created by the Administrative Office of the Courts pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:43-21.
