Dear Mr. Kim,

This letter is in follow-up to my letter dated June 8, 2020 concerning your OPRA request which sought access to the following:

- 1. A list of all lawsuits and cases in which any officer of the police department was involved between 2012 and 2019. For each lawsuit/case, please provide the date (month and year) of the alleged incident at issue, whether the alleged incident was excessive force, settlement amount (if any), and final compensation amount ruled (if any).**
- 2. Please provide copies of the complaint in any lawsuits and cases described above.**

In my letter, I asked if you could contact me but I have not heard from you. Please be advised that the Town of Dover does not maintain a list of all lawsuits and cases as described in your request. Accordingly, there are no responsive documents to either item of this request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Dover to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
