Dear Sir/Madam,

The Township of Washington received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on May 27, 2020. The official Records Custodian, Susan Witkowski received your OPRA request on May 28, 2020. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is June 8, 2020. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 8th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

As attached (OR-195)

Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill because of the current guidelines of the COVID19, the staff is in the building for a limited time, the rest of the time working from home remotely. Having said that, OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

Your request requires an extension of time until June 19, 2020.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Washington to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
