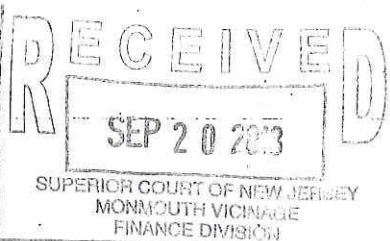

TO ENSURE MY SAFETY, THE SAFETY OF A CIVILIAN.

AT THE END OF APRIL 2018, AFTER MY OLD ROOMMATE CAME BACK FROM A REHABILITATION PROGRAM THE EATONTOWN POLICE THREW ME ON THE STREETS WHILE I WAS ATTENDING A RESTAURANT JOB. I INFORMED THE EATONTOWN POLICE IN THE POLICE STATION THAT I WON'T STAY IN EATONTOWN NEW JERSEY WITHOUT A RESIDENCE JUST FOR A RESTAURANT JOB. I TOLD THE POLICE TO INFORM THE ROMANIAN EMBASSY FROM WASHINGTON D.C. AND TO GET ME MY PASSPORT, A BOARDING TICKET AND RESIDENCE AT MY DESTINATION.

BECAUSE MY REQUESTS WERE NOT MET I WAS FORCED TO TAKE A KITCHEN JOB AVAILABLE IN THE GREEK RESTAURANT SIX DAYS A WEEK FOR LUNCH AND DINNER. IN MAY I MADE A REQUEST TO GET AN APARTMENT IN MIDDLETOWN NEW JERSEY AS ADVISED BY THE CITY HALL FROM MIDDLETOWN.

I DIDN'T GET AN APARTMENT, A CAR OR SOMEONE TO DRIVE ME TO WORK AND I WAS FORCED TO SPEND THE MONEY EARNED IN THE RESTAURANT TO THE LOCAL HOTELS USING THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION UNITS AND TAXI.

AT THIS KITCHEN JOB I EARN APPROXIMATELY ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AFTER TAXES EVERY TWO WEEKS; AND OVER TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS EVERY MONTH AFTER TAXES. IN MAY, JUNE, JULY AND AUGUST I MADE OVER EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS AT THIS NEW KITCHEN JOB I WAS CONSTRAINED TO TAKE. MY BANK ACCOUNT WAS CLOSED BECAUSE MY EMPLOYER MISSPELLED MY NAME ON ONE OF MY PAYCHECKS THAT I DEPOSITED IN MY BANK ACCOUNT THROUGH ONLINE BANKING.

AFTER LOOKING IN MY WALLET I DON'T SEE THE EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS IN CASH I EARNED AT MY NEW JOB. THE EATONTOWN POLICE ENSLAVED ME TO WORK FOR THIS COMMUNITY, TO PRODUCE WELFARE WITHOUT A PRIVATE RESIDENCE, A CAR, ESORT, GIRLFRIEND, WITHOUT HAVING MY SAFETY

AFTER AUGUST 2017 WHEN I CAME BACK TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA I WORKED IN EATONTOWN, NEW JERSEY FOR THE GREEK DINER, FOR THE GREEK RESTAURANT APELLA THAT IS NOW CLOSED AND FOR PERKINS EATONTOWN, NOW CLOSED UNTIL NOVEMBER 2017. I TOOK THE ENGAGEMENT TO CONTINUE MY WORK IN THE RESTAURANT INDUSTRY AND I SIGNED FOR TWO JOBS AT THE MALL IN EATONTOWN ONE AT BOBBY'S BURGER PALACE AND ONE AT TGI FRIDAYS I WAS ACCEPTED FOR THE JOBS BUT BOTH THE EMPLOYERS TOLD ME THAT I CAN START WORKING WHEN I GET THEM A IDENTITY DOCUMENT OR SOME OTHER DOCUMENT THAT AUTHORIZES ME TO WORK BECAUSE MY DRIVING LICENSE WAS EXPIRED. AFTER I WAS PROPERLY ADVISED I USED PART OF THE MONEY SAVED FROM MY OTHER JOBS TO PAY FOR A WORK AUTHORIZATION DOCUMENT AT IMMIGRATION.

BECAUSE IN DECEMBER 2017 I WASN'T CALLED AT WORK AFTER PAYING FOR THAT DOCUMENT AND I WAS LEFT WITHOUT AN INCOME, I REQUESTED TO MOVE TO CHICAGO ILLINOIS OR TO SWITZERLAND. I WAS KEPT HERE WITHOUT AN INCOME, ISOLATED FROM ACCESSING COMMUNICATIONS, WITHOUT A CAR, GIRLFRIEND IN AN APARTMENT WITH AN OLD MAN AT 145 SOUTH ST APT 15 EATONTOWN, NJ 07724. I DIDN'T GET ACCOMMODATION, RELOCATION OR OTHER ACCESS TO CREDIT FROM THE GOVERNMENT OR PRIVATE SECTOR.

I WAS KEPT IN THAT APARTMENT TO BE TORTURED PHYSICALLY AND PSYCHOLOGICALLY UNTIL FEBRUARY 2018 WHEN I GOT A PART TIME JOB IN A GREEK RESTAURANT IN LINCOLN NEW JERSEY. UNTIL GETTING THAT JOB I WAS ATTACKED BY CRIMINALS AT THAT RESIDENCE AND THE SKIN FROM MY FACE AND HANDS WAS DAMAGED BADLY. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES REFUSED

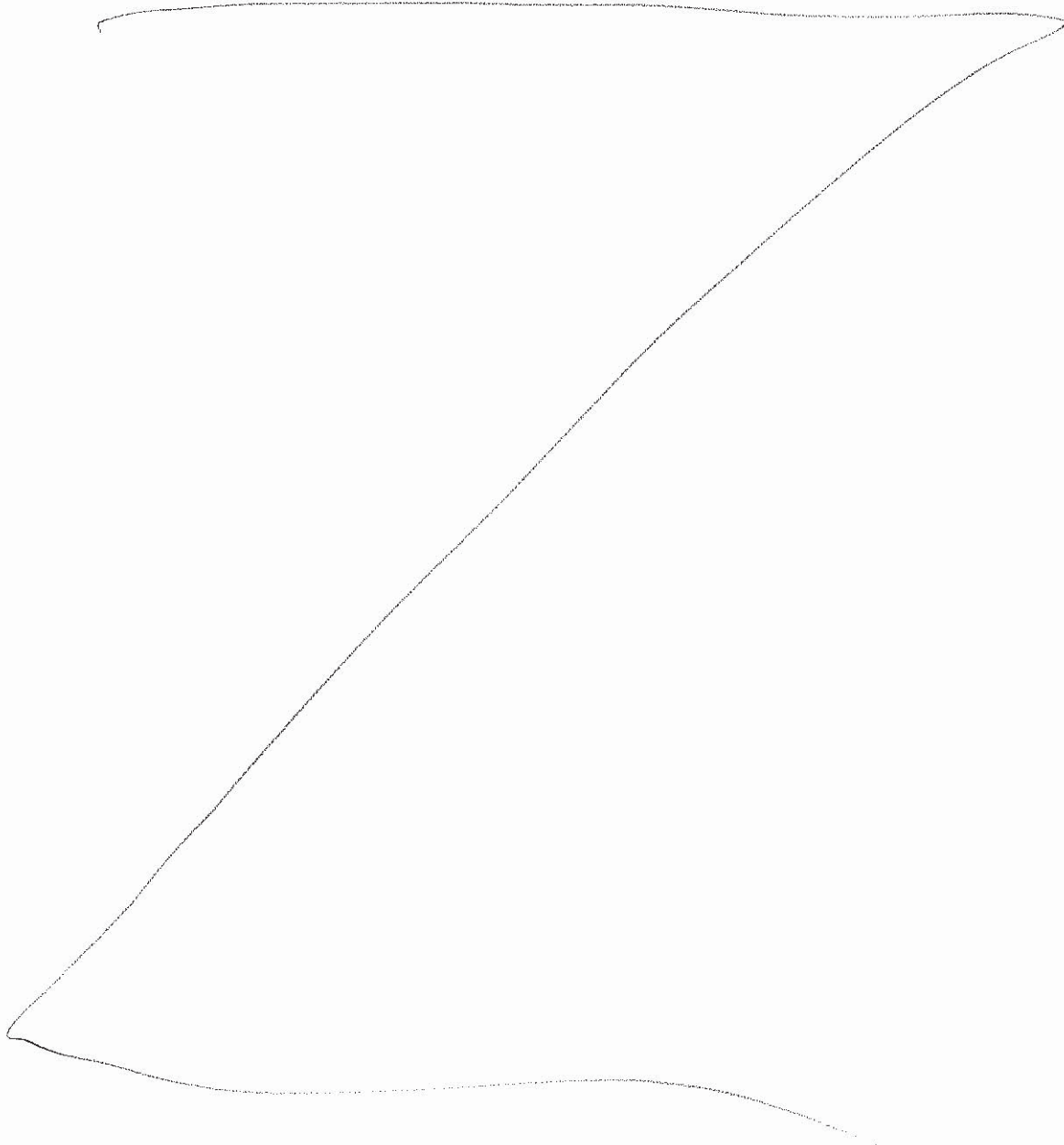
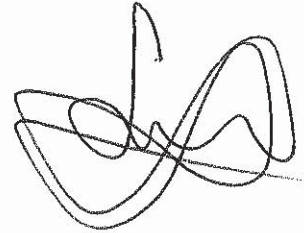
