If the complaint is one in foreclosure, then you must file your written answer or motion and proof of service with the Clerk of the Superior Court, Hughes Justice Complex, P.O. Box 971, Trenton, NJ 08625-0971. A filing fee payable to the Treasurer, State of New Jersey and a completed Case Information Statement (available from the deputy clerk of the Superior Court) must accompany your answer or motion when it is filed. You must also send a copy of your answer or motion to plaintiff's attorney whose name and address appear above, or to plaintiff, if no attorney is named above. A telephone call will not protect your rights; you must file and serve a written answer or motion (with fee of \$ 135.00 and completed Case Information Statement) if you want the court to hear your defense.

If you do not file and serve a written answer or motion within 35 days, the court may enter a judgment against you for the relief plaintiff demands, plus interest and costs of suit. If judgment is entered against you, the Sheriff may seize your money, wages or property to pay all or part of the judgment.

COMPLAINT AND
JURY DEMAND

Plaintiffs residing in the Township of East Hanover, County of Morris Sussex by way of
Complaint against the Defendants state:

BACKGROUND

1. On or about December 28, 2011, the Defendant Brian Ford, a member of the Florham Park Police Department, went to the Morris County Prosecutor's Office and obtained a warrant to search various premises associated with the Plaintiff, Nancy Ritschel.

2. John Doe, a member of the Morris County Prosecutor's Office approved the warrant described above. The same was submitted to the Honorable Philip J. Maenza, J.S.C. who signed the same.

3. Armed with the warrant which was obtained as the result of a purposely flawed warrant, searched the Plaintiff's home, motor vehicles and her place of employment.

4. The Defendant Brian Ford and John Does entered the premises of the Plaintiff, removed items belonging to the Plaintiff and retained the same for more than a year.



5. The Defendants herein never had probable cause to seek a warrant. Defendant from the Florham Park Police Department never investigated statements by third parties, never determined that statements given to them were false but acted without investigation and with malice.

6. The Defendants appeared at the home of the Plaintiff with nine police cars and embarrassed the Plaintiff Nancy Ritschel both in her personal life and in her business life.

7. Items seized by the various Defendants were destroyed.

8. The Florham Park Defendants held the Plaintiffs Cindy Rullo, Racquel Rullo and Heather Rullo incommunicado for a long period of time, would not let them communicate with their mother and detained them.

COUNT ONE

1. Plaintiffs repeat each and every allegation as if set forth at length herein.

2. The Mayor and Council of Florham Park, as well as supervisors within the Florham Park Police Department, did not properly train Detective Brian Ford.

3. As a result of the improper training, the said Defendant Ford applied for and obtained a warrant without proper investigation based upon statements that were known to be false.

4. As a result of the improper conduct of the Defendants described herein, the Plaintiff and her daughters were humiliated, embarrassed, injured and suffered the loss of their freedom as well as personal property.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for compensatory and punitive damages, costs of suit and attorney fees.

COUNT TWO

1. Plaintiffs repeat each and every allegation as if set forth at length herein.

2. Defendant Brian Ford failed and refused to investigate false statements given to him by third parties and embarked upon a course of conduct which led to the injuries sustained by the Plaintiff Nancy Ritschel and her daughters Cindy Rullo, Racquel Rullo and Heather Rullo.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for compensatory and punitive damages, costs of suit and attorney fees.

COUNT THREE

1. Plaintiffs repeat each and every allegation as if set forth at length herein.
2. All of the Defendants named herein were instrumental in causing the damages sustained by the Plaintiffs.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for compensatory and punitive damages, costs of suit and attorney fees.

COUNT FOUR

1. Plaintiffs repeat each and every allegation as if set forth at length herein.
2. John Doe, a member of the Morris County Prosecutor's Office, approved without probable cause a warrant to be submitted to a Superior Court Judge for the purpose of searching the residence, motor vehicles and the business property of the Plaintiff without just cause.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for compensatory and punitive damages, costs of suit and attorney fees.

COUNT FIVE

1. Plaintiffs repeat each and every allegation as if set forth at length herein.
2. A representative of the Morris County Prosecutor's Office, John Doe, and Detective Brian Ford of the Florham Park Police Department, together prepared and Affidavit and Search Warrant to be submitted to a Superior Court Judge.
3. The Affidavit to be submitted was without investigation, was prepared with malice and submitted to a Superior Court Judge.
4. As a result of the activity of John Doe and Brian Ford, the Plaintiff and her daughters suffered damage.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for compensatory and punitive damages, costs of suit and attorney fees.

COUNT SIX

1. Plaintiffs repeat each and every allegation as if set forth at length herein.
2. Defendant Brian Ford and others mentioned herein, falsely imprisoned the Plaintiff and her daughters, held them incommunicado, and caused damage as described above.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for compensatory and punitive damages, costs of suit and attorney fees.

COUNT SEVEN

1. Plaintiffs repeat each and every allegation as if set forth at length herein.
2. Defendants herein together and individually violated the Civil Rights of the Plaintiffs.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment for compensatory and punitive damages, costs of suit and attorney fees.

JURY DEMAND

The Plaintiffs hereby demands a trial by jury.

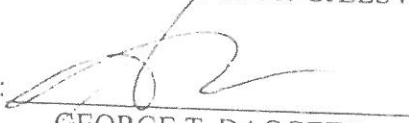
