Re: Open Public Records Act

Dear Taeho Kim:

The Borough of Gibbsboro Records Custodian receive Open Public Records Act (OPRA) on May 8, 2020. Accordingly, the initial seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request under OPRA is June 8, 2020. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(i)(2), effective March 20, 2020, this response is being provided beyond the initial seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request under OPRA due to the declared state of emergency.

Your records request was as follows:

1. A list of all lawsuits and cases in which any officer of the police department was involved between 2012 and 2019. For each lawsuit/case, please provide the date (month and year) of the alleged incident at issue, whether the alleged incident was excessive force, settlement amount (if any), and final compensation amount ruled (if any).
2. Please provide copies of the complaint in any lawsuits and cases described in above.

There are no records that respond to your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Gibbsboro to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
