Dear Mayor Altamonte:

As you are aware, this office was previously retained by the Monmouth Joint Insurance Fund for purposes of representing your interests in the above referenced matter. As you may recall from my earlier correspondence, our review of the Plaintiff's Complaint revealed that the Plaintiff did not obtain proper service of process upon you. As of my correspondence dated January 28, 2019, we were taking a "wait and see" position with respect to whether or not the Plaintiff intended to perfect his claim by way of proper service. To date, he has not.

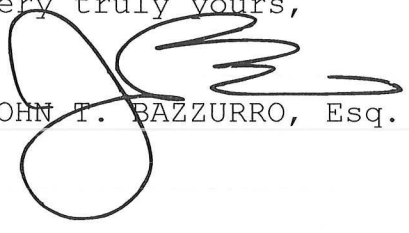
In this regard, we have been monitoring the Federal Court's website for purposes of determining what actions, if any, the Plaintiff has taken with respect to perfecting this case. In this regard, the Federal Court has dismissed the Plaintiff's Complaint without prejudice for failing to properly prosecute the case. To date, the case remains dismissed. Despite the Plaintiff's prior attempts to reinstitute the action properly, he has failed in doing so. Basically, over the last several months, he has not filed any additional documentation and, as such, we believe that the Plaintiff is abandoning his claim.

Accordingly, at this point in time, I will be closing my file in this matter and you should consider the case to be closed based upon the Plaintiff's failure to prosecute same. However, please be advised that, in the event you receive any

further documentation and/or information concerning this matter from either the Plaintiff or a process server, I would request that you immediately inform both my office and the Monmouth Joint Insurance Fund so that we may respond appropriately and in a timely manner.

Of course, should you have any questions with regard to the above, please feel free to contact me. It has been a pleasure representing you in this matter and hopefully, this will be our last communication concerning same.

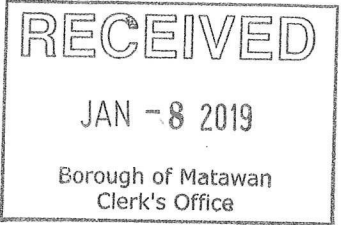

2. Stan Chervin took my possessions unlawfully and without my consent. Hanne Eid and Marian Miawad stand as accessories after the fact and are also as liable as is Stan Chervin for the crimes against i.

3. Officer Chrisopher Stark of Matawan Police Department threaten i; derek; with arrest and allowed and unlawfully trespass and taking of my property, called 99 Aberdeen road, Matawan, New Jersey, and possessions held therein. a criminal act of taking without consent, theft, larceny.
