WHEREAS, after lengthy litigation, discovery, conferences, mediation and negotiations, and in an effort to avoid the expense and uncertainty of the continued prosecution and defense of this litigation, and without the admission of any liability, the parties have reached a settlement to dismiss the lawsuit with prejudice captioned Byron Halsey v. Frank Pfeiffer, et al, filed in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey, Civil Action No. 09-1138 (CCC) (MF) on the part of the City, reached a settlement to dismiss the lawsuit against the City, with prejudice; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Plainfield previously granted settlement authority to the Corporation Counsel in the amount of \$6,265,200.00 during its Executive Session to settle this lawsuit on behalf of the City of Plainfield in the amount of \$6,265,200.00; AND

WHEREAS, among the other terms and conditions, Halsey has agreed to accept from the City of Plainfield on behalf of Frank Pfeiffer the settlement amount of \$6,265,200.00, inclusive of all costs and attorney's fees, as follows:

\$6,265,200.00 - payable by the City of Plainfield (\$4,900,000.00 - from insurance proceeds (MidStates Policy) and \$1,365,200.00 from the City's Budget - four payments of \$341,300.00 to be paid over 4 budget years).

WHEREAS, the payment of \$1,365,200.00 is to be paid in four (4) equal payments of \$341,300.00 as follows:

\$341,300.00 - 1st payment on or before July 22, 2015;

\$341,300.00 - 2nd payment on or before July 15, 2016;

\$341,300.00 - 3rd payment on or before July 15, 2017;

\$341,300.00 - 4th and final payment on or before July 15, 2018; AND

WHEREAS, there is sufficient funding for the first payment of \$341,300.00 from the City of Plainfield's budget line 5-01-46-870-001-235 pursuant to an Emergency Appropriation in the amount of \$341,300.00 duly approved on July 20, 2015; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield, does hereby authorize and approve the final settlement of the matter of Byron Halsey v. Pfeiffer, et al, Civil Action No. 09-1138 (CCC) (MF), Inservco Claim No. 1940002098 in the amount of \$6,265,200.00, of which \$4,900,00.00 will be paid from insurance proceeds; be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield, does hereby authorize the remaining balance of \$1,365,200.00 of the settlement to be paid in four (4) equal payments of \$341,300.00, the first payment to be made on or before July 22, 2015 as provided by the Emergency Appropriation budget line 5-01-46-870-001-235; be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield hereby agree to budget \$341,300 in the calendar years 2016, 2017 and 2018 in order to make the remaining payments on July 15, 2016, July 15, 2017, and July 15, 2018; be it

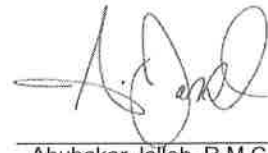
WHEREAS, to indemnify Officer Michael Black as to compensatory and punitive damages will result in the removal of one law firm from the present matter; Now, therefore, be it
