Dear Mr. Kuhn:

I am writing in response to your request pursuant to the Open Public Records Act ("OPRA") received on January 14, 2021. The seven (7) business day deadline to respond is January 26, 2021. As such, the City is timely responding to your request in accordance with New Jersey law.

Your request is as follows:

- I am looking for all code violations going back to January 2020. In violation I am referring to violations a property has whether it be grass or weeds over growth, excessive rubbish, defective plumbing, exposed wiring etc.
- All Tax Delinquents/Liens
- Vacant/Abandoned Properties
- Utility Delinquent/Liens

As a threshold matter, please be advised that the City does not maintain a list of vacant/abandoned properties, and as such, is not in possession of any records which are responsive to that portion of your request.

With respect to the remainder of your request, redactions have been made to remove personal telephone numbers in order to protect the individual's reasonable expectation of privacy pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1. See also N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 (exempting "unlisted telephone numbers" from the definition of a "government record"). In addition, Executive Order 26 (McGreevey 2002) provides that information relating to an individual's medical, psychiatric or psychological history, diagnosis, treatment or evaluation is not subject to OPRA. Accordingly, redactions have also been made to remove references to medical and/or psychological condition(s).

Your OPRA request is now deemed answered and closed.
