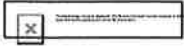

The competitive Municipal Aid grant program attracted 635 applications from 549 different municipalities with a total of \$342 million requested. Project applications were evaluated and rated on their merits by NJDOT staff and reviewed by an independent panel of New Jersey municipal engineers. This process resulted in 548 awards to 543 municipalities, totaling \$161.25 million. The 2016 Transportation Trust Fund renewal has made it possible to continue to award \$161.25 million annually – more than double the \$78.75 million that was available before the TTF renewal. In addition, the extra funds have allowed the Department to increase the number of municipalities receiving grants from about 370 a year prior to the TTF renewal to 543 municipalities this year.

Hi Senator--

Please allow me to take a moment of your time to share with you how upset I am with certain Republicans in my town of Atlantic Highlands, Highlands and Sea Bright.

Before I go any further, I hope you will keep this correspondence between the two of us. If there are portions you'd like to share with others, please reach out so we can discuss.

I was on the phone tonight talking with my borough administrator when I offhandedly mentioned the proposed school merger with Sea Bright (I said that given the pandemic, the last thing we should be considering is paying any more taxpayer dollars regarding this poorly considered proposal). Imagine my surprise when I was informed that there is a

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secret meeting being held with the mayors and business administrators of all three towns mentioned above-- as well as Charlie Rooney, yourself and Declan O' Scanlon. Also a Republican councilman from AH.

I say "secret" because none of the Democrats from Atlantic Highlands was informed or invited to this meeting.

Vin, it's important that you know you're being dragged into an operation that's been orchestrated by local Republicans- - and your fellow Democrats are against this half baked idea.

Charlie Rooney, Loretta Gluckstein, Brian Boms, Rosemary Ryan and the Montecalvo family have been pushing this idea for two years under the guise of saving taxpayer dollars. When you read the proposal, you'll see that there's almost zero chance that'll happen. There are other motivations for why this is being crammed down people's throats, but at the risk of sounding like a conspiracy theorist, I'll save that for a phone chat (or a lunch when we're able to do that again).

Let me pass along some other reasons why this proposal is a bad idea:

1. We support the decision of the three Board of Education's to pass on this proposal. They are the ELECTED experts and we should respect their unanimous position on the matter.
2. This doesn't make financial sense for AH-- the formula would eventually put Atlantic Highlands in the same financial position that Sea Bright currently finds itself in.
3. Our tri district is already a statewide model for cost sharing. Even this proposal says there's probably no other cost sharing/ savings to be found with a merger.

4. Twenty five Sea Bright kids are not going to move the needle in the direction of Mr Sweeny's "path forward" plan.

5. The proposal admits THERE ARE NO GUARANTEED SAVINGS TO TAXPAYERS WITH A MERGER.

6. HOWEVER, There are GUARANTEED ADDITIONAL COSTS with a merger (busing... insurance... re negotiated teacher salaries... foreign language translators... special ed needs, etc).

7. Solution #1: Force Shore Regional to renegotiate with Sea Bright. Vin, why lose \$3.5 million from your district when you might be able to keep \$1.5 or \$2 million?

8. Failing a new deal with Shore Regional, and rather than unravel a tri- district that's working (disbanding our boats, e.t.c), let's allow Sea Bright to attend our schools under a simple send/recieve agreement?

9. Shore Regional will sue Sea Bright, Atlantic Highlands and Highlands over this merger. Why would we want to engage in costly litigation during a pandemic and certain depression?

10. During a pandemic, there's absolutely no reason to spend \$25k on a special election (and another \$10k on extending the Sea Bright legal team who wrote the proposal).

I think you know that I pushed to make the proposal published (much to the consternation of my Republican counterparts) because they are hoping to bully this through the system-- hence, secret meetings where Dems aren't informed). Likewise, I also pushed to hold a public townhall to discuss this proposal because I firmly believe once the

Atlantic Highlands voters see how much a merger will ultimately cost them, further talk of a merger will be stopped in its tracks.

Thank you for the quick response. I am aware that you have had contact with the mayor and borough administrator and appreciate it, but our residents are suffering, especially our seniors. At this heat level, nearly everyone without a generator has had to throw out all the food in their COVID-stocked refrigerators (I myself tossed about \$400 of food at 5:15pm).
It has been frustrating that the communications system has been challenging to access and information has at times been confusing. We have several residents reporting that they received a call or text this evening stating their power has been restored but it has not.
We do appreciate the efforts of the folks on the ground and are quite concerned for their safety, especially in this COVID time. I am grateful that you have confirmed they are working around the clock. I am quite familiar with the extensive tree damage as my 75 yard long driveway is filled with debris stacked about four feet high and six feet deep.
Can you help me understand who in particular is affected by the recloser, whether that is something the JCP&L team has locally, and what the timeframe of installation will be? I'm going to assume since you

Councilwoman –

I certainly empathize with how long residents in Atlantic Highlands have gone without power. I have remained in contact with Mayor Gluckstein and Adam Hubeny several times each day throughout this event, communicating with them about issues related to 34.5 kV lines feeding substations in the area. Our crews have worked Atlantic Highlands as a priority due to the sheer volume of people who were out and because of the severe damage that impacted key infrastructure.

5

As I'd imagine you know by now, nearly 1,200 customers in Atlantic Highlands have had their power restored since 1:45PM today. Your municipality went from a 100% outage in the aftermath of this storm to an outage of 18%, as 480 customers remain without power. That is still too high and we are working around the clock to bring those outages to completion. Moving forward, there are about 300 customers that will be restored with the installation of a recloser. As we work to complete this outage, calls are dispatched in the order that will bring the most customers back online.

You can be sure that this was not an issue of resources or supplies. Our region was devastated when a natural disaster – Tropical Storm Isaias – struck. Infrastructure across the state (not just in JCP&L coverage areas) was destroyed by high winds and tree damage – lots and lots of tree damage. Thousands of additional utility personnel were brought in prior to the storm and thousands continue to deploy here – released from coverage areas throughout the nation that were not impacted as severely as we were.

On top of all of this, COVID-19 presented a unique challenge to our utility personnel, who are constantly working in very close quarters in dangerous conditions.

We understand the frustration, but we did our best to communicate at the outset that this would be a multiple-day event, so people could make appropriate plans.

Kiley have announced that today, March 25, there are 359 new positive cases of COVID-19 in Monmouth County. There are two new deaths being reported today related to COVID-19 in Monmouth County.

The County Commissioners and the Monmouth County Health Department (MCHD) are strongly urging residents to do their part to slow the spread by practicing social distancing, wearing a face covering when social distancing is not possible, not gathering in large crowds, washing their hands and staying home when sick.

Monmouth County will offer free COVID-19 testing for County residents on Tuesday, March 30 in Neptune from 4 to 7 p.m. at the Neptune Senior Center, 1607 State Route 33. Residents should note the clinic has 200 tests and once those are administered, the clinic will close for the day.
