My colleague Paul Anzano suggested that I contact your office. I'm the Mayor and public safety director of Avon by the Sea. I was also a prosecutor for 25 years. We are deeply concerned that S-3454 will effect our ability to control underage cannabis smoking on our beach this summer. We thank you for spearheading the effort to amend S3454 to allow for parental notification. However, there are other troubling provisions of S-3454. As the Assembly stated in its findings, the intent of the voters and the enabling legislation to prevent the sale of cannabis to those under 21. S 3454 provisions will have such a chilling effect on enforcement for anyone suspected of being underage that for all intents and purposes, it is creating a form of immunity for those under 21.

Avon approved a resolution calling for the repeal of the most problematic provisions of S3454. Assemblyman Kean has a bill to eliminate one of those provisions. We would suggest that you consider a
