I am copying my colleague Senator Singer as this is an issue we have spoken about and as you know, he represents you in Bradley Beach. I am sending a similar message to as many other towns in Monmouth County as possible.

The Governor and Legislature recently announced up to 10 million dollars in potential grants through DCA for any town, school district or authority which would like to consider shared services.
