Hello everyone. I hope you are all well and finding opportunities to enjoy the warmer weather.

I've attached the timeline that Tracey put together, which you'll see is framed in the Sustainable Essex Alliance's case study and provides links to sample resolutions and ordinances. Please forgive the lag in getting this to you as COVID has created some strain in our work loads, as you can imagine.

What you'll see outlined in the attached document is once Red Bank adopts a resolution to be the lead agent, the next step for each town will be to adopt a resolution accepting RB as the lead. This will not bind any town to the cooperative, but it will allow RB to send out the RFP to hire an energy consultant on behalf of the group, which is necessary to move the ball forward. Once the energy consultant is hired, they will take the lead in helping to coordinate each step moving forward.

In total, each town will need to pass 2 resolutions and 1 ordinance (1. accepting RB as the lead, 2. establishing the RGEA aggregation program within the municipality (required by state law), and 3. officially joining the cooperative purchasing system).

If at any point in time a town wants to pull out (or join in), they can do so up until the creation of the cooperative purchasing system (resolution #3). That said, if there is a significant change in the number/size of towns, the consultant may decide to adjust their fee structure.

As I understand it to be at this point, Asbury Park, Eatontown, Freehold Borough, and Red Bank are committed to moving forward and exploring the potential energy and cost savings with an energy consultant. Unfortunately, George notified me that Long Branch is removing itself from this process for now due to a shift in priorities, but may be interested in joining in at a future point if this group enters a second contract for RGEA.

You have a great group to move forward with! I'm excited to see where this process takes you all. It is Sustainable Jersey's recommendation that each town first pass the resolutions expressing support for Red Bank being lead agent; and then Z drafts the RFP for input from the group so that an energy consultant can be hired which will really kick start this process. I know you are all eager.

Please don't hesitate to reach out with any questions. There are a number of people from the SEA RGEA cooperative who would be more than happy to provide advice moving forward. Annette De Palma, who you all met at our first meeting in Eatontown, coordinated the group's process and is a great source of information especially for Z as lead agent. She can be reached at adepalma@twp.maplewood.nj.us.

Another great resource is our [RGEA action](#), which also has model ordinances/resolutions.

The competitive Municipal Aid grant program attracted 635 applications from 549 different municipalities with a total of \$342 million requested. Project applications were evaluated and rated on their merits by NJDOT staff and reviewed by an independent panel of New Jersey municipal engineers. This process resulted in 548 awards to 543 municipalities, totaling \$161.25 million. The 2016 Transportation Trust Fund renewal has made it possible to continue to award \$161.25 million annually – more than double the \$78.75 million that was available before the TTF renewal. In addition, the extra funds have allowed the Department to increase the number of municipalities receiving grants from about 370 a year prior to the TTF renewal to 543 municipalities this year.

Hello, Amit,

It's been a while. I hope you are well and enjoying your new assignment. I left a message on your voice mail a short while ago and wanted to follow up with an email.

I've been working as the administrator in Keyport since I left Bayonne. As you are likely aware, due to its strategic location, Keyport is the gateway to the Jersey Shore. At Exit 117 on the Parkway, thousands of people pass through our community on their way to Sandy Hook and the Shore communities. We are located at the confluence of NJ Route 35 and 36 and, as such, experience tons of traffic on each highway. We are also located near the Hazlet and Matawan/Aberdeen NJ Transit Rail Stations and the Hazlet Academy Bus Depot.

We have some concerns about issues that involve NJ DOT and the County of Monmouth. Specifically, they involve the following:

- NJ Route 36 was resurfaced during the previous administration. The project took forever due to the misguided moratorium related to the TTF. Once the moratorium was lifted, it took forever to get the contractor re-mobilized to address punch list items. Ped heads were not activated, HC ramps were left unfinished and project and detour signs were left strewn about. Now NJ Route 35 is being worked on but there seems to be no plans to complete the work on 36 where the road passes beneath 35. The road way is in complete disrepair full of potholes, poor drainage and broken asphalt. Despite repeated requests, we have not been able to get this problem addressed. To compound matters the area is part of a heavy merge of traffic from exit 117. On top of having to avoid the pot holes and rough roadway, you have to be alert for a dangerous merge. Last night one of our council members broke a strut on his vehicle in this exact area. We do get frequent calls from residents wanting to know who is going to pay for damage to their vehicles from this area. We need some help getting the road way and dangerous merge addressed.
- Keyport has a fair number of residents who commute to work in North Jersey and New York via NJ Transit Rail Services. Unfortunately, both stations have extremely limited parking facilities and it is nearly impossible to drive to either station with the reasonable expectation of getting a parking spot. People frequently walk to the Hazlet station but unfortunately, there is no pedestrian crossing at Route 35. Pedestrians and bicyclists are left to dodge traffic to get to the station. Over at the Matawan/Aberdeen Station, the Henry Hudson Trail could serve as a conduit to the station but it remains incomplete. WE could use some assistance in finding funding and completing this important transportation link. We would also like to discuss finding funding to obtain a jitney bus to help us move people from the community to the train and bus stations and complete the last mile to transit.
- Clark Street on the border between Keyport and Hazlet is a main conduit to and from the entrance to the Parkway. Unfortunately the road is in need of a serious upgrade to continue in use. WE could use some assistance in rehabilitating this important roadway connection to the parkway.
- The parkway interchange, the gateway to the Bayshore, an opportunity to make a good first impression on thousands of visitors to this critical NJ tourist resource is, frankly, a depressing sight. It would benefit everyone if we could get a serious upgrade to the on and off ramps to and from routes 35 and 36.

We would greatly appreciate the opportunity to meet with the appropriate personnel from NJ DOT to discuss these and other transportation related issues to the benefit of our citizens, commuters and visitors to the region. Your kind assistance in arranging such meetings or pointing me in the right direction would be greatly appreciated.

Thank you in advance for your kind assistance in this regard. I look forward to hearing from you.

Vin,

The Borough of Keyport is served by reasonable proximity to NJ Transit stations in Aberdeen/Matawan and Hazlet. However, there are virtually no parking spots ever available at either station. Pedestrian and bicycle access is dangerous especially when crossing Route 35 at County Route 4 and over the steep, and poorly designed County route 516 bridge. Likewise pedestrian and bicycle access to the Academy Bus Depot on Route 36 is devoid of safe passage from Keyport on County route 516 which has no sidewalks.

We are also having problems with the confluence of routes 35 and 36 which are full of pot holes and need to be repaved.

Also, Clark street serves as a major conduit to and from the Parkway but we receive no support from the highway authority to maintain it.

Ideally, the borough would like to collaborate with the state and the county to improve pedestrian and bicycle access to transit, obtain and run a community jitney bus to the train stations and the bus depot and provide bicycle storage solutions at each facility. We would also like to see the Henry Hudson Trail Extended to Aberdeen to allow for pedestrian/bicycle access to transit.

Could you direct me to the proper person to set up a meeting with NJDOT to discuss these issues and develop a plan to begin addressing them? I'm happy to go to Trenton or wherever at any time.

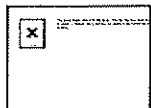

The competitive Municipal Aid grant program attracted 635 applications from 549 different municipalities with a total of \$342 million requested. Project applications were evaluated and rated on their merits by NJDOT staff and reviewed by an independent panel of New Jersey municipal engineers. This process resulted in 548 awards to 543 municipalities, totaling \$161.25 million. The 2016 Transportation Trust Fund renewal has made it possible to continue to award \$161.25 million annually – more than double the \$78.75 million that was available before the TTF renewal. In addition, the extra funds have allowed the Department to increase the number of municipalities receiving grants from about 370 a year prior to the TTF renewal to 543 municipalities this year.

Dear Governor Murphy,

We, the undersigned elected officials from across New Jersey, are concerned about the health, prosperity, and resiliency of the communities we represent in the wake of the global pandemic and economic crisis. We urge you to continue New Jersey's participation in the multistate Transportation and Climate Initiative (TCI) to bring needed investment dollars for sustainable infrastructure and reduce pollution in our communities; we hope New Jersey will strongly advocate for equity commitments from the other states to make the regional policy as strong as possible, and that you will sign the final MOU when it is released later this year.

Thank you for your leadership in addressing the climate emergency by signing our state's landmark electric vehicle (EV) law, rejoining the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI), joining the multistate agreement to advance zero-emission heavy-duty vehicles, developing the first-of-its-kind New Jersey Wind Energy Port, supporting a vision for a 100% clean energy future articulated in the updated Energy Master Plan, and helping prepare New Jersey for climate impacts with the Coastal Resilience Plan. With the important state mandate of 80% carbon emission reductions by 2050, New Jersey is emerging as a national leader in transitioning away from harmful fossil fuels to 100 percent clean energy.

To meet these ambitious goals, we must make substantial investments across New Jersey to modernize our transportation infrastructure and reduce harmful pollution that is worsening our public health and climate emergencies.

The urgency for these investments has increased in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic. As we know you are very aware, more than fifteen thousand people have lost their lives and over one million people are out of full-time work.^{1,2}

Pollution from our transportation sector has substantially worsened the pandemic's impacts. According to a recent Harvard study, air pollution is a major contributor to deaths from COVID-19 and is greatly compounding the current crisis.³

With heightened exposure to pollution, people of color are more than twice as likely to die from COVID-19.⁴

The transportation sector makes up 42 percent of New Jersey's greenhouse gas pollution.⁵

Yet, pollution from transportation is clearly within our power to change. Global emissions fell by 17 percent during pandemic lockdowns, with 43 percent of the decrease coming from fewer cars, buses and trucks on the roads.⁶ As we rebuild our economy, we have an opportunity to reduce our pollution, increase economic opportunity, and help drive our recovery by investing in a clean, affordable, and efficient transportation sector.

The draft policy the TCI states are discussing will generate as much as \$750 million annually to invest in clean transportation projects in New Jersey. Building on and complementing RGGI, which has generated more than \$155 million for our state, TCI will be a substantial new source of proceeds to support needed clean transportation projects in local communities, including transit, local bicycle and walkway projects, electric vehicle infrastructure, Safe Routes to School, and Safe Routes to Transit.⁷

TCI enables states to choose where proceeds are allocated, so not only do we have the ability to reinvest these sustainability projects at large, but we can tailor programs to specific community needs.

The program will reduce pollution and improve public health, and help make our communities cleaner and greener. According to the [Georgetown Climate Center](#), by joining the final TCI MOU, New Jersey can help reduce regional pollution by 63 percent, prevent more than 1,000 pollution-related deaths, and generate \$10 billion in reduced health costs.⁸

New Jersey can choose to use the generated revenue to invest in projects that create multiple benefits for our communities, such as clean transit near affordable housing, safer routes to schools, and climate-resilient infrastructure. The proceeds from TCI can make this possible.

Strengthening health, prosperity, and resiliency in communities of color and economically marginalized communities must be central to any transportation investment program. We urge you to support a series of complementary policies to ensure that environmental justice principles are included in the implementation of TCI, including increased air monitoring in high-traffic areas, establishing an oversight committee of community leaders from frontline communities, and ensuring equitable investments that benefit all New Jerseyans.

The need for bold, science-based action to address the climate emergency has never been clearer. Implementing a cap and invest program for the transportation sector will help New Jersey rebuild our economy, clean our air, and address the disproportionate impacts too many communities bear.

We stand ready to work with you to build a cleaner, healthier, and more prosperous New Jersey for all.

The competitive Municipal Aid grant program attracted 635 applications from 549 different municipalities with a total of \$342 million requested. Project applications were evaluated and rated on their merits by NJDOT staff and reviewed by an independent panel of New Jersey municipal engineers. This process resulted in 548 awards to 543 municipalities, totaling \$161.25 million. The 2016 Transportation Trust Fund renewal has made it possible to continue to award \$161.25 million annually – more than double the \$78.75 million that was available before the TTF renewal. In addition, the extra funds have allowed the Department to increase the number of municipalities receiving grants from about 370 a year prior to the TTF renewal to 543 municipalities this year.
