The competitive Municipal Aid grant program attracted 635 applications from 549 different municipalities with a total of \$342 million requested. Project applications were evaluated and rated on their merits by NJDOT staff and reviewed by an independent panel of New Jersey municipal engineers. This process resulted in [548 awards to 543 municipalities, totaling \\$161.25 million](#). The 2016 Transportation Trust Fund renewal has made it possible to continue to award \$161.25 million annually – more than double the \$78.75 million that was available before the TTF renewal. In addition, the extra funds have allowed the Department to increase the number of municipalities receiving grants from about 370 a year prior to the TTF renewal to 543 municipalities this year.

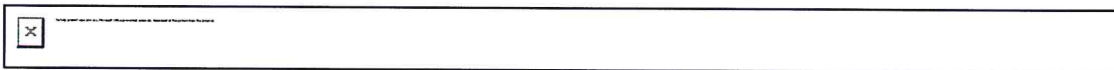

Dear Friend,

Starting Monday March 22, the Second Phase Rental Assistance Program for New Jersey Residents Impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic will be officially open for applications.

The federally-funded program will provide approximately \$353 million in rental assistance to low- and moderate-income households that have had a substantial reduction in income as a result of the pandemic, including those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

Applicants for the COVID-19 Emergency Rental Assistance Program Phase II (CVERAP Phase II) may be eligible for up to 12 months of rental assistance to help pay for rent arrears incurred after March 13, 2020, and future rent to the extent that funds are available. Households that already received assistance in Phase I of the program but need additional rent support and have not yet received the maximum 12 months of emergency rental assistance (including CVERAP Phase I) can apply for additional funding.
