The band books a travel agency every year. To my knowledge, they have always used a travel agency. They take trips every two years. The company dictates the costs to us. I would assume that their costs include their fees to use them. From the beginning, all three directors have said the trip would cost \$2000 and that we had hoped that it would be cheaper. It is definitely a large expense to attend a Disney trip.

I answered your other questions below.

On Tue, Jan 11, 2022 at 7:38 PM [REDACTED] wrote:

Wow!! I always knew trips that we attended to be cheaper than the actual cost of going individually. I was asked about these prices from some different folks about this trip because they know we vacation there a lot and vacation overall frequently as a passion. I just wanna be clear in some details and not speak out of turn to anyone about my thoughts and I know you're the expert. So if I can go over a few more things and ask a few more things as to not take up much more of your time and I truly appreciate you sending me the information and for your time.

So the flight actually costs \$700 just to get to Orlando on a frontier airline which is priced at \$425 currently per my travel agent? **Correct. This is the price they gave us for 132 flights on the same plane, direct flight, out of Trenton, through Frontier.**

The room for a total of five nights cost \$1085 per student so the room costs over \$4000 in an all-star hotel? The price of that hotel for four people to stay in is extremely below that price currently per travel agent. **Correct. This is the price they gave us. I assume this cost includes meals and possibly park tickets? They have not given us a park breakdown cost, so this might be included in this. I am unsure.**

Orlando motorcoach price includes getting from the airport there and back or one-way for that price of \$119? **To my knowledge, this is for all transportation. To and from the Trenton airport, to and from the Orlando airport, and all transportation while in Disney to and from the hotels and parks.**

I just want to be clear I understand all of this so I don't speak on anything unless I am sure because I am a big supporter of the theater and any trip that is taken but I also am cognizant of peoples financial situations at this time and current prices outside of these specific booked trip prices for the students to do the same thing. **I hope all of the parents are confident in knowing that I am giving the exact prices and costs that the company is giving me. They send me an invoice and I make that work for our children. Any parent that has reached out to me with a**

financial hardship I have worked with.

Also, other questions. How food works? Meaning they get three meals a day are but are they quick service meals or can they eat at a restaurant, what are the limitations and guidelines? **I was told that they get 3 meals cards a day that they can use wherever they want. Now, me being a Disney person, I believe they are for quick service meals. I am sure they will give us more info as we get closer to the trip.**

How many students are attending this TRN trip? **I believe 132. There are 20 theatre students coming.**

Just for verification purposes to help us fully be accurate- we have paid two installments thus far correct? \$300 and \$800? **Incorrect. Theatre students have paid \$100, \$325, and \$800.**
