@1926 Responded to 22 Jackson St. for a possible working fire. On arrival Battalion-1 assumed command from Ladder-2. An investigation found an oven fire in apartment #1 Front. Located on the 2nd floor. All fire was contained to the oven. The occupants had already used a Dry Chem extinguisher to control the fire before our arrival. A small amount of fire was still burning in the lower warming drawer. Ladder-2 members used a water can to extinguish all remaining fire. When checking for extension with a TIC. A large rag was in the bottom warming drawer. This was the cause for the fire. The rag was removed and put into the kitchen sink. The entire building was ventilated with multiple fans. The owner was on the scene. The occupants and owner were advised that the gas to the Oven was shut off by the Fire Department. And that they cannot restart the appliance before it gets inspected by PSE&G. The tenants were given PSE&G telephone number to schedule and appointment. The alarm system was reset and holding. Command terminated 2001.

At 1926 hrs. responded to 22 Jackson St. for report of a possible structure fire. Upon arrival established command and conducted investigation. Found moderate smoke condition in the common hallway area leading up the apartment where the fire was located. Ladder 2 crew located the source of the fire which was located in the bottom drawer of a stove where there was cloth towels inside that were on fire. Prior to our arrival the initial extinguishment was by the tenants utilizing a Dry chemical extinguisher. During the operation Command was assumed by B/C 1. Ladder 2 completed with the extinguishment utilizing water extinguisher of the content inside the stove, secured the gas line to the stove, and utilized fans to vent out the entire building of the smoke condition. After completion of the tasks Ladder 2 was released by command and available at 2001 hrs.
