Pre-connect 2, which was the second line was at the ready for back up. Crews from 2990/2975 assisted with establishing a water source from the hydrant located at the corner of Johnson Ave/Little Street. Fire was extinguished quickly and scene was turned over to Local Fire Official for investigation. 2978 returned to quarters.

I arrived on location and establish command. I had a 200x100 two-story type 2 construction. The fire was on the Charlie/delta side of the building by the patio. Active fire was going and Pd was on location trying to extinguish the fire. So I geared up and put my Scott pack on and grab the water can to see if I could knock the fire down. At that time i knock some of the fire down, but it was not enough. 2966 arrived on location and I transfer command to him. 2978 and 2975 call service. I went inside to check for extension. I had heavy smoke on the first floor and second floor so I radio to command to strike out a box alarm. As I was checking the first floor and second floor. 2978 arrived on location and stretched 1 3/4 line . 2975 was the supply truck to 78. Crew from 2978 knock down the rest of the fire. Why that was going on I was inside opening on the wall up on the first floor and the second floor rooms where the fire was located to check for extension. No fire extended . Command recalled the box alarm because it was not need it. 2930 was dispatched out and arrived on location to do his investigation. They had a video camera system that seen how the fire started. The fire started accidental by a cigar ashes. That was this guarded not the proper way in the ashtray they caught the fence on fire. The best location was complete. No fire department was needed, and all residence were allowed back in to the building after being evacuated. No injuries or harm was done to anybody . And no fire department activity was needed anymore. The property in the building was handed over to the manager. The manager was having a company come out and secure the damage to the building. All district 29 units were cleared by 2966.
