Dear Tony,

The Town of Secaucus received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on June 12, 2026. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is June 23, 2026. Please accept this letter in response to your request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

“All available body-worn camera footage from October 30, 2025, report case number 25-051390”

A link containing the BWC footage was sent to you, you will be receiving an email From AXON containing link, redactions have been made to personal identifying information pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 and MDT screens. if for some reason it appears you have not received the files relative to your request, we kindly ask that you check your spam/junk mailboxes as it may have been filtered to that location instead.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Secaucus to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
